TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Mendenhall Glacier & Nugget Falls** — The essential Juneau stop.
 - **Humpback Whale Watching** — Juneau is one of the world's top humpback spots.
 - **Helicopter Glacier Landing & Dog Sledding** — Fly over the Juneau Icefield, land on a glacier, and mush a dog team
- across the ice.

 - **Mount Roberts Tramway** — Right at the downtown dock — rise 1,800 ft for panoramic Gastineau Channel views, a Tlingit culture theater, eagle...
 - **Sea Kayaking — Auke Bay or Gastineau Channel** — Paddle calm waters through rainforest scenery.

BEST WALKS

- **Downtown Seawalk & Capitol Loop** ~2.5 km · 1–1.5 hrs · easy · flat — From the dock, follow the Seawalk past Marine Park's bronze whale sculpture, up S.
- **Perseverance Trail — Gold Creek Canyon** ~5 km out-and-back · 2–3 hrs · moderate · some elevation — Juneau's most rewarding town-accessible hike.
- **Nugget Falls Trail (at Mendenhall)** ~3 km out-and-back · 1 hr · easy · flat gravel — If you make your own way to Mendenhall (bus or shuttle), this flat path leads along the lakeshore to the base of the thundering 377-ft...
