GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Gili Mas deep-water pier (large ships); tender at Lembar Harbor (smaller vessels)

Best For: Beach lovers, culture seekers, foodies after spicy Sasak cuisine

Walk to center: Nothing walkable from port — transport required to reach towns or beaches

Don't Miss: Ayam Taliwang (Lombok's iconic spicy grilled chicken)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Selong Belanak Beach** — Arguably one of Asia's most beautiful beaches: a wide crescent of soft white sand with shallow turquoise water.
- Sasak Village (Sade or Ende)** — Living examples of indigenous Sasak culture.
- Taman Narmada Park** — Built in 1727 by a Balinese king as a miniature replica of Mount Rinjani and its crater lake, complete with royal...
- Southwest Gilis Snorkeling (Gili Nanggu & Gili Kedis)** — The 'secret Gilis' — uninhabited sandbar islands with pristine coral reefs, sea turtles, and crystal-clear water.
- Mataram Islamic Center & Pura Lingsar** — Lombok's defining contrast in one trip: the grand Hubbul Wathan Mosque with its soaring dome and city views from the...

BEST WALKS

- Ampenan Old Town Wander** ~30 min • Easy • History & Photography — Lombok's original port district retains crumbling Dutch colonial shophouses, a busy fish market, and a relaxed harbor front.

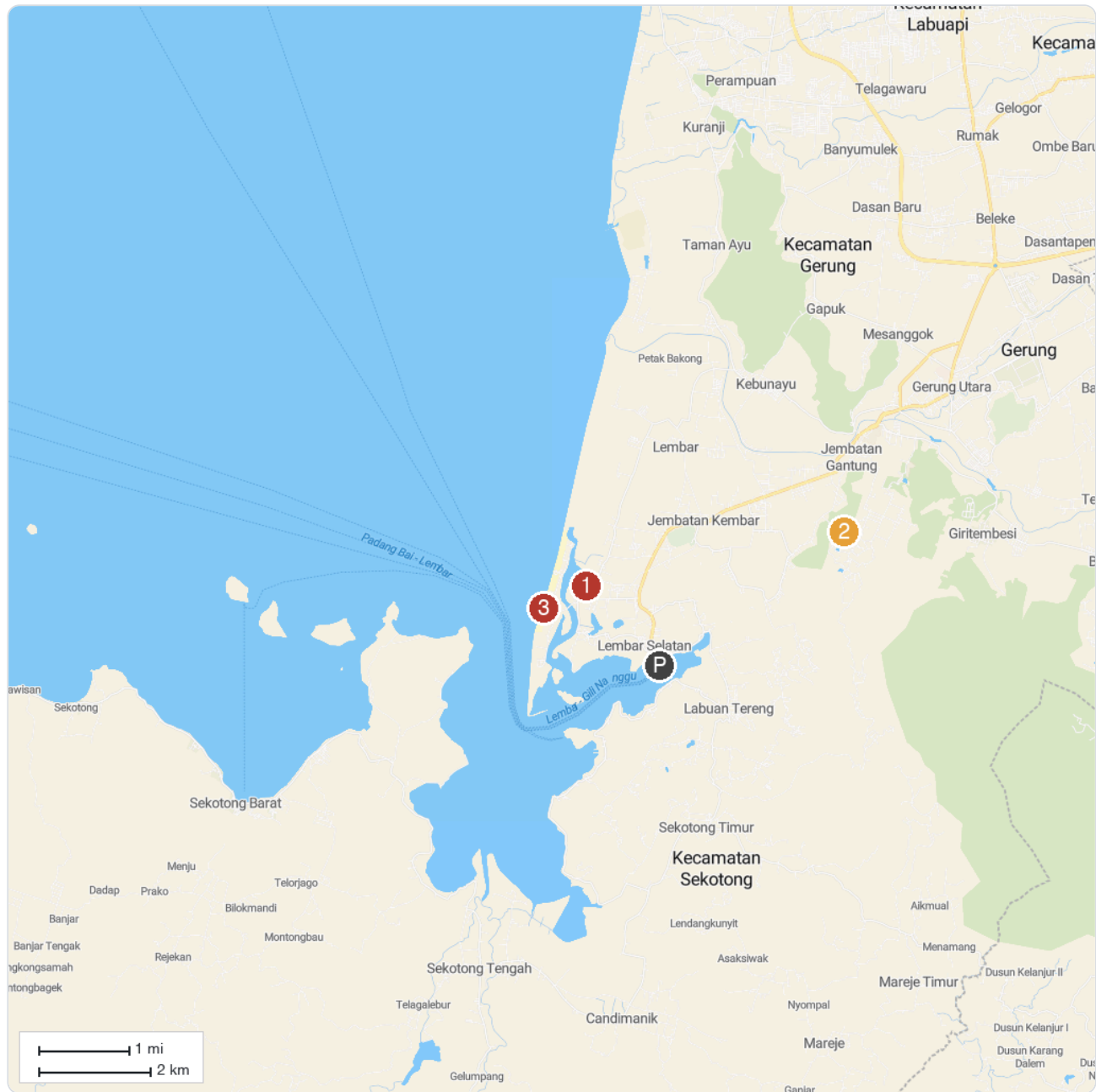
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring cash in rupiah. ATMs at the terminal work, but small temples, drivers, warungs, and markets are cash-only. ~\$1 USD = 15,000–16,000 IDR.
- Dress modestly away from the beach. Lombok is 90% Muslim — cover shoulders and knees when visiting mosques, temples, or Sasak villages. Saroni rentals available at most sites...
