Don't Miss: Tuesday, Friday, or Sunday morning market on the central square

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Saint-Émilion Wine Village** — The UNESCO-listed hilltop village of Saint-Émilion is just 9 km away.
- **Libourne Morning Market** — On Tuesdays, Fridays, and Sundays, Place Abel Surchamp fills with local cheeses, truffles, fresh oysters, charcuterie...
- **Pomerol Château Visit** — Pomerol borders the town itself.
- **Libourne Bastide Walking Tour** — Founded in 1270 by an English lieutenant of King Edward I, Libourne is a classic bastide — a fortified grid-planned town.
- **Bordeaux City Day Trip** — Bordeaux is only 20-30 minutes by direct train from Libourne station.

BEST WALKS

- **Quay to Town Center** 30 min · Easy · Flat — Walk the renovated riverfront north from your ship, passing the Tour du Grand Port (the last medieval city gate), then turn into the...
- **Station Loop for DIY Day-Trippers** 20 min one-way · Easy — Walk from the pier along the quay to the town center, then continue inland to Gare de Libourne.

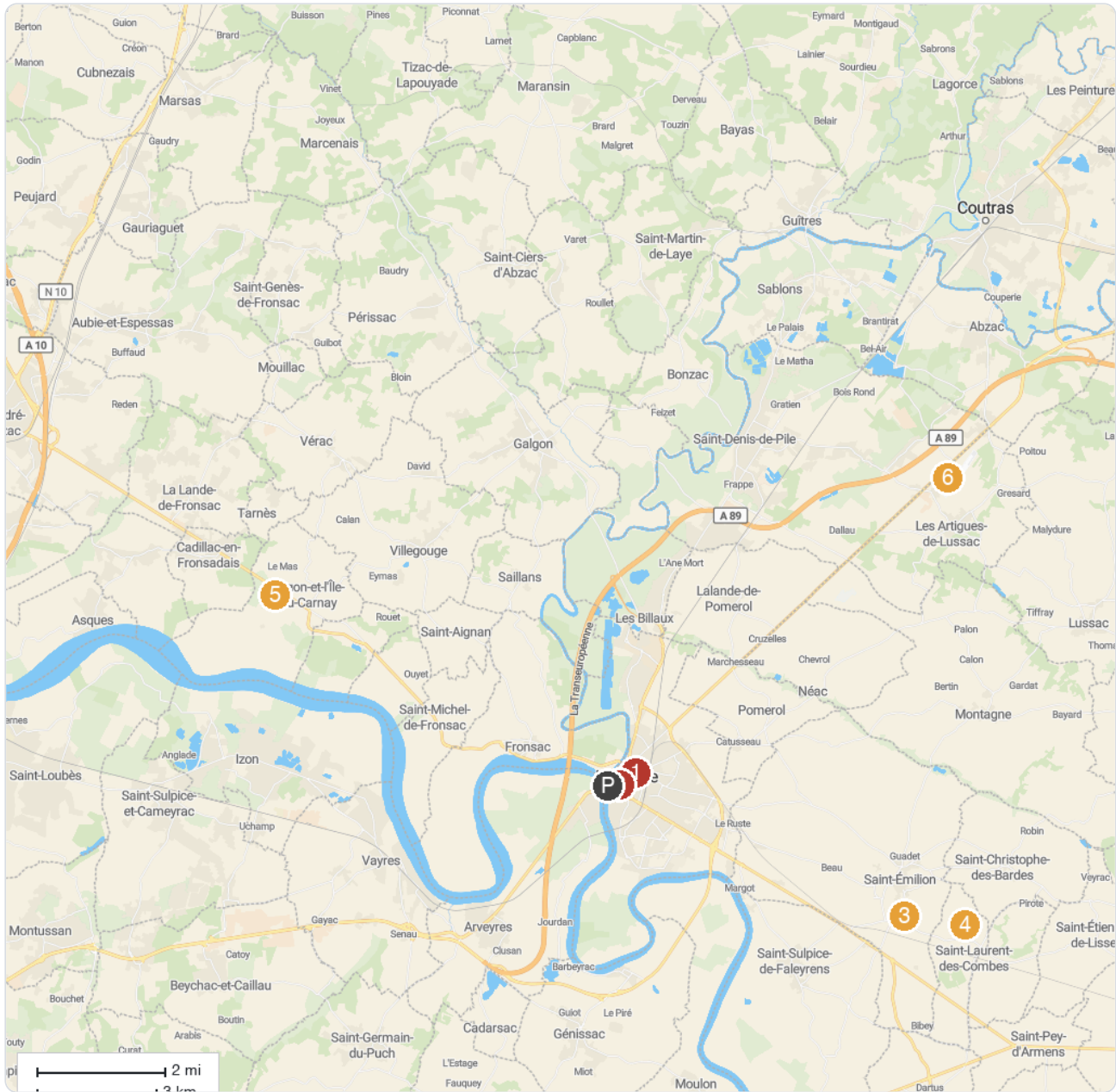
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Check your docking day. Libourne's famous market runs Tuesday, Friday, and Sunday mornings. If you're docked on Monday or Wednesday, most shops may be closed — lean on ship...
- Train to Saint-Émilion is easy — but the station there is at the bottom of the hill, 20 min steep walk up to the village. Pre-book a taxi or take the ship's excursion if mobility...
