GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside on the Rhine promenade — no tender required

Best For: Medieval architecture, local wine, and leisurely strolling

Walk to center: ~200-300 m (3-5 min) through the historic Rheintor gate

Don't Miss: Burg Linz glassblowing and the half-timbered Rathaus on Marktplatz

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Burg Linz Castle & Glassblowing Workshop** — Built in 1365 by the Archbishop of Cologne, Burg Linz houses artisan craft shops, a Roman-style glassblowing workshop...
- **Altstadt Walk — Historic Half-Timbered Town Hall** — Stroll Rheinstraße and the Buttermarkt past brilliantly painted 15th- and 16th-century Fachwerk houses.
- **St. Martin's Church — Medieval Frescoes** — Begun in 1206, this hilltop church preserves exceptional 13th- through 15th-century wall paintings rarely seen outside...
- **Rhine Riesling Tasting** — Linz sits in the Middle Rhine wine region.

BEST WALKS

- **Altstadt & Burg Linz Loop** 1.5 km · 45-60 min · Easy (cobblestones) — From the Rhine pier, pass through the Rheintor gate, walk up Rheinstraße to Marktplatz to see the half-timbered Rathaus and (if timed...
- **Up to St. Martin's Church** 0.8 km each way · 20 min · Moderate (uphill lane) — From Marktplatz, follow the signposted lane up to St.

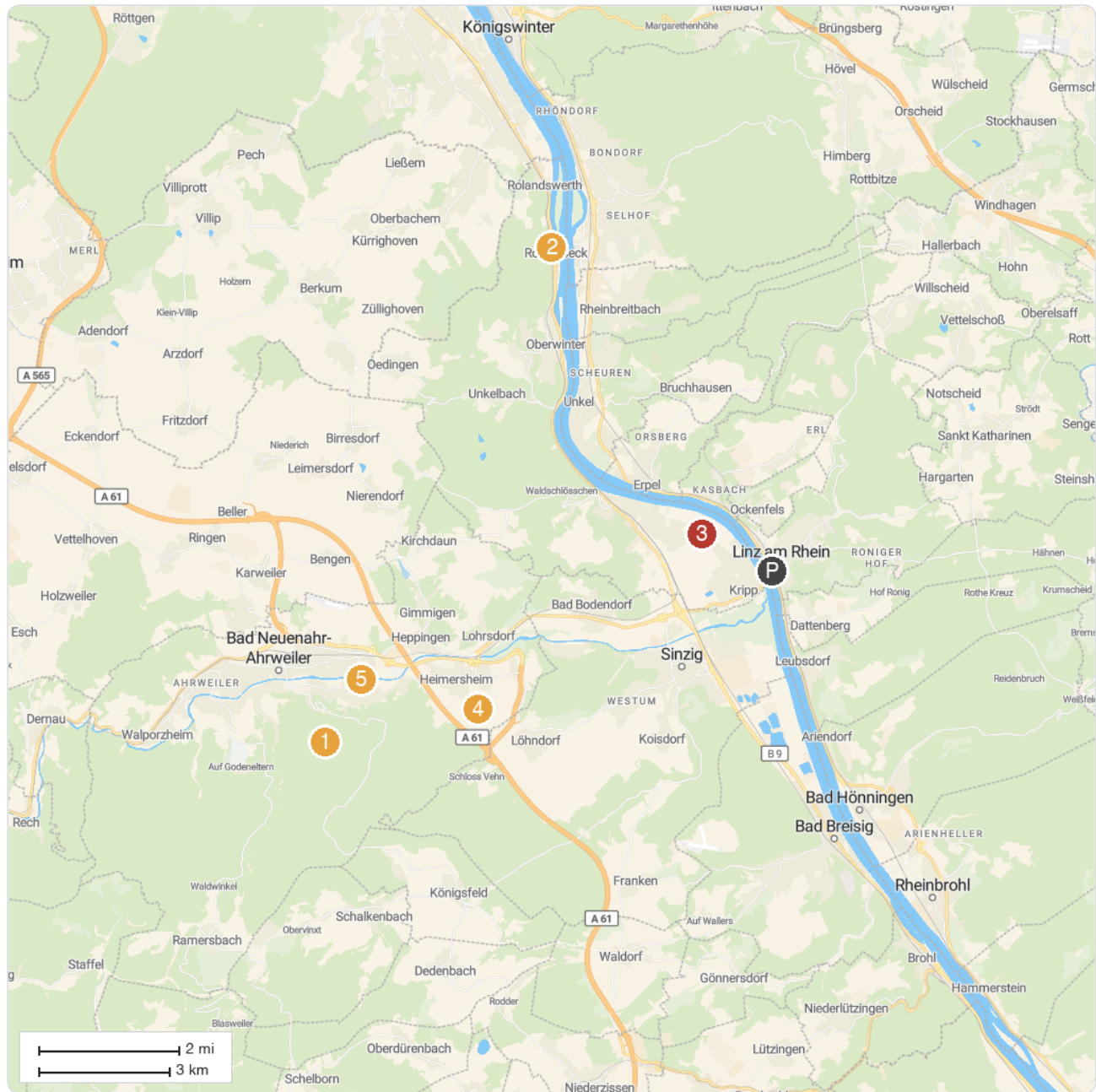
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Wear sturdy shoes. The Altstadt is entirely on cobblestones and slopes uphill toward the castle and church — heels are not practical.
- Carry cash. Small cafes, bakeries, and souvenir stalls may not accept card payments for small amounts; keep a few euros handy for coffee and public toilets.
