Docking: Tender to Lister Hafen (List Harbour)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Ellenbogen Dunes & Lighthouses** — Cycle or walk the 4.5 km to the Ellenbogen (Elbow) peninsula — Germany's northernmost point — passing wild sheep...
- **Wadden Sea Seal Watching Cruise** — Board an Adler-Schiffe boat at List Harbour for a cruise across the UNESCO Wadden Sea to see harbour seal colonies...
- **Sylter Royal Oyster Tasting** — Visit Dittmeyer's Austerncompagnie, a short walk from the harbour, to see the indoor seawater purification basins where...
- **Naturgewalten Forces of Nature Museum** — Highly interactive exhibition on the geology, weather, and ecology of Sylt and the Wadden Sea — right at the harbour.
- **West Beach & Strandkorb** — Take the bus or bike to Sylt's wild North Sea-facing West Beach.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbour Village Stroll** 1 km · 20 min · Flat — From the tender dock at List Harbour, walk the boardwalk past GOSCH, the Naturgewalten museum, and Dittmeyer's Oyster Company, then...
- **Königshafen Bay Walk** 3 km · 45 min · Easy — Head north from the harbour along the edge of Königshafen (King's Harbour), a calm sheltered bay.

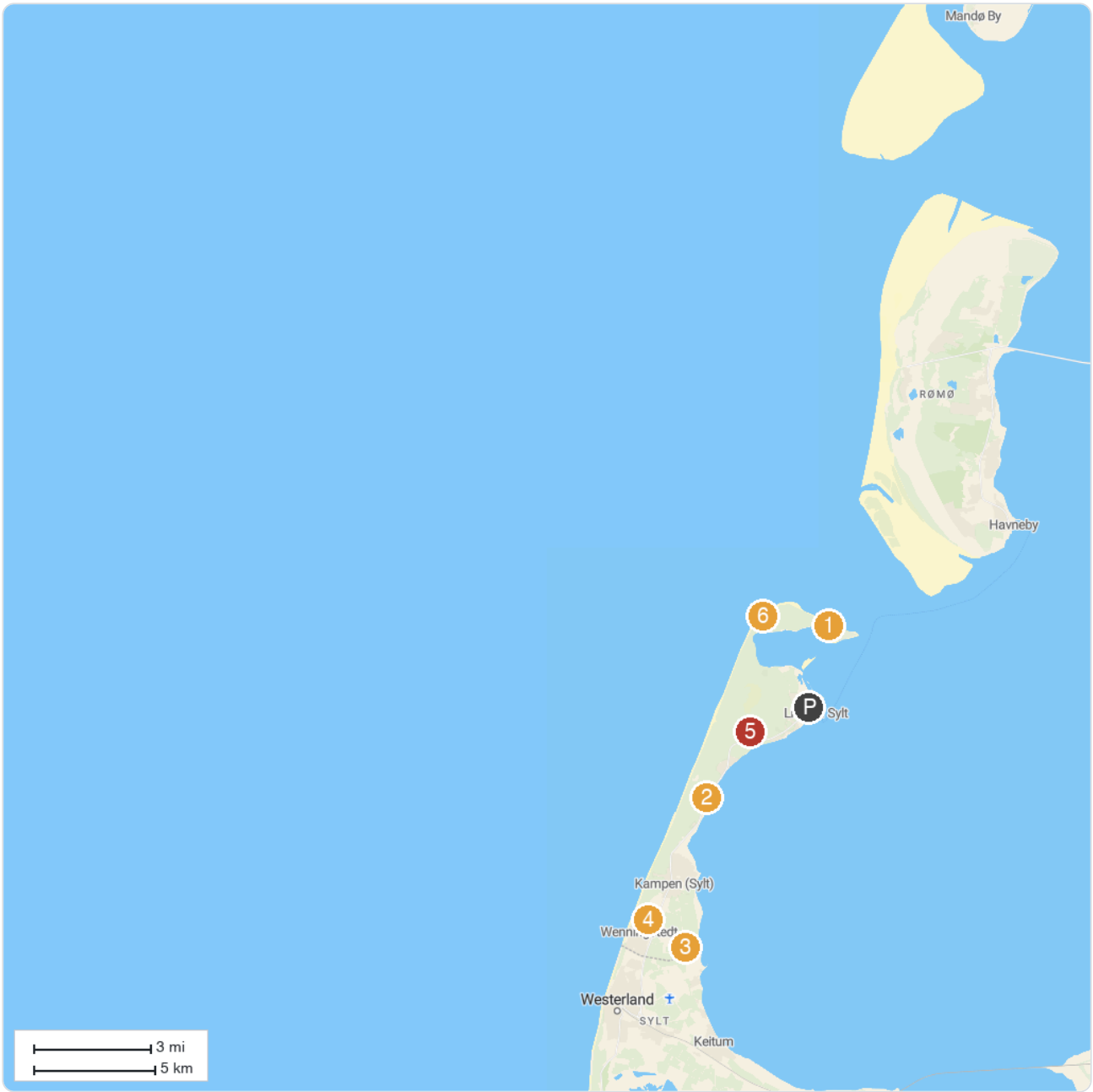
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
