TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Urban Bourbon Trail** — Walk Whiskey Row and tour 2–3 of Louisville's downtown distilleries.
- **Louisville Slugger Museum & Factory** — The 120-foot steel bat leaning against the building makes it unmissable.
- **Muhammad Ali Center** — A world-class museum dedicated to Louisville's most famous son — his boxing career, humanitarian work, and six core...
- **Big Four Bridge Walk** — A converted 19th-century railroad bridge now carries pedestrians across the Ohio River to Jeffersonville, Indiana.
- **Churchill Downs & Kentucky Derby Museum** — The legendary home of the Kentucky Derby.

BEST WALKS

- **Whiskey Row & Museum Row Loop** 1.5 miles | ~45 min | Easy — Walk south from the wharf up to Main Street, stroll past the cast-iron facades of Whiskey Row (one of the largest such collections in...
- **Big Four Bridge to Indiana** 1.2 miles round-trip | ~30 min | Easy — Head east along the Waterfront Park path to the Big Four Bridge pedestrian ramp.

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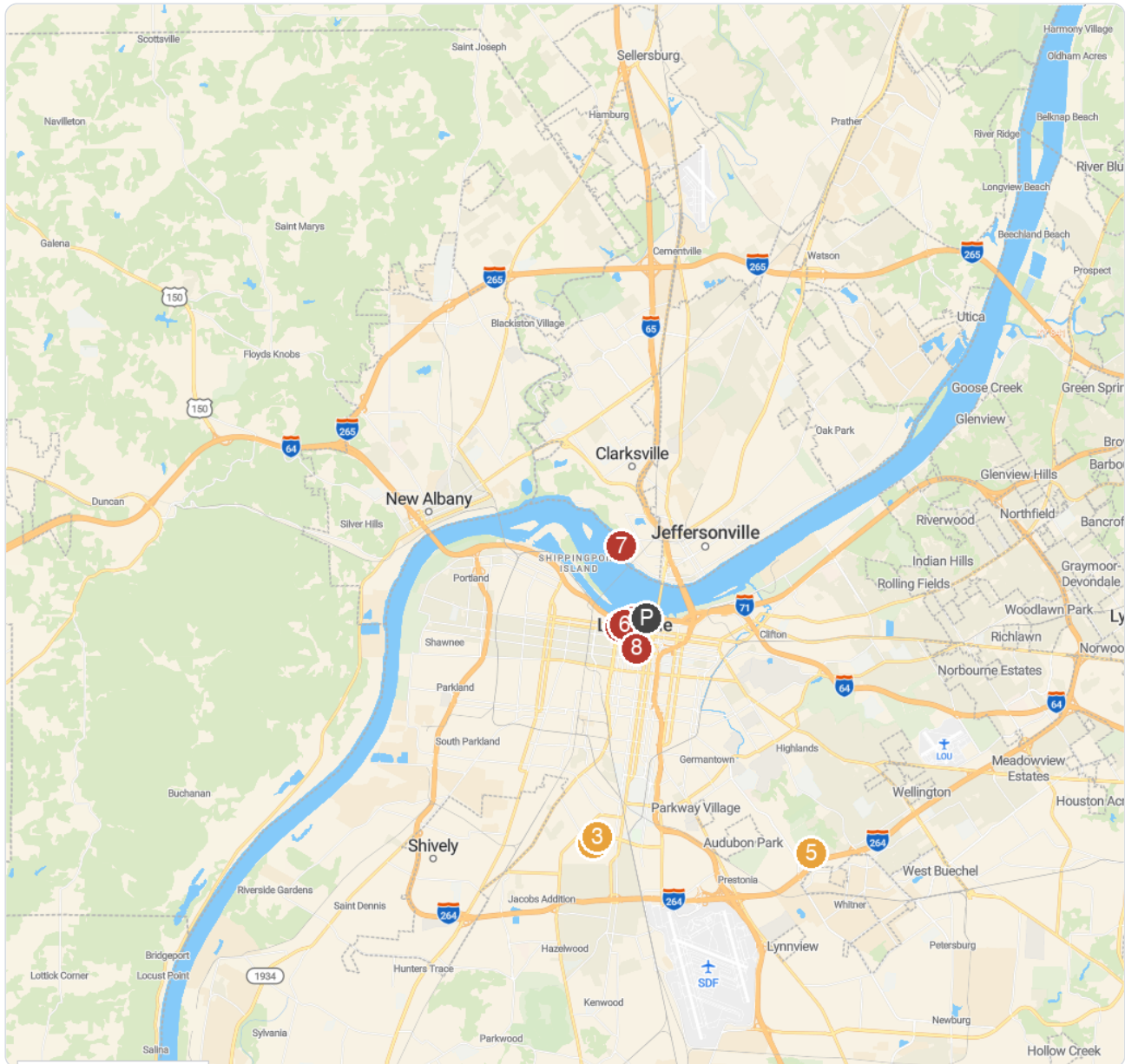
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book distillery tours in advance. Old Forester, Angel's Envy, and Evan Williams on Whiskey Row are popular — reserve your tasting slot before arrival, especially on weekends.
- Say it right. Locals say "Loo-a-vuhl" — not "Lewis-ville." It's a small thing that gets a big smile.
- Derby timing matters. The Kentucky Derby runs the first Saturday in May. If your cruise coincides, expect crowded venues, higher
