TOP THINGS TO DO

- Puffin Watching at Jenny's Cove** — Walk the west coast path to Jenny's Cove to spot Atlantic puffins nesting in cliff burrows.
- Seal Spotting at Landing Bay** — Atlantic grey seals are resident year-round and frequently haul out on the rocks near the jetty.
- Marisco Castle & Old Light** — The 13th-century Marisco Castle was built by Henry III to repel pirates.
- West Coast Cliff Walk** — Follow the western cliff path for dramatic Atlantic views and to look for Lundy Cabbage — a yellow-flowered plant that...
- Lundy Stamp Post Office** — Buy a postcard at the General Store, attach a Lundy island stamp alongside a Royal Mail stamp, and post it from the...

BEST WALKS

- Jetty to Village & Marisco Tavern** 0.6 mi · 15–25 min · Steep climb — The essential walk for every visitor.
- Village to Old Light Lighthouse** 0.5 mi · 10–15 min · Easy — From the village, walk north along the ridge to the 1819 Old Light lighthouse at the island's highest point.
- West Coast Cliff Walk to Jenny's Cove** ~2 mi one-way · 45–60 min · Moderate — Head west from the village across the plateau then follow the cliff path north to Jenny's Cove — the best spot for puffin watching in...
