Where the Lyngen Alps plunge straight into an Arctic fjord. Lyngseidet is a small, authentic Norwegian village backed by snow-capped peaks — an expedition favourite for hikers, kayakers, and anyone chasing the midnight sun.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small quay or tender; most expedition ships use the ferry pier

Walk to centre: Village centre is right at the pier — 2 min walk

Best For: Hiking, fjord scenery, whisky distillery, Arctic photography

Don't Miss: Lyngentrappa — 1,200 steps to a 468 m viewpoint over the fjord

Getting around: **Taxi** NOK 100–200 (~\$9–18 USD) for short trips

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Lyngentrappa — The Lyngen Stairs** — Hike 1,200 steps (completed 2022) from the fjord shore up to 'Verdens Ende' (World's End) at 468 m.
- Lyngenfjord Kayak** — Guided sea-kayak tours paddle beneath the peaks of the Lyngen Alps with reflections of glaciers and snow-capped summits...
- Aurora Spirit Distillery Visit** — Located 12 km north of Lyngseidet, this is the world's northernmost whisky distillery.
- Fjord Fishing & Wildlife Cruise** — Head out on Lyngenfjord to fish for cod, haddock, and coalfish while scanning for sea eagles, porpoises, and — in...
- Lyngen Church & Village Walk** — Lyngen Church (1782, on a site used since c.1740) is one of northern Norway's oldest churches.

BEST WALKS

- Village Centre Stroll** 30 min · Flat · Free — From the pier, walk to Gollis (the 9 m Santa Claus statue), Prestelvparken, Lyngen Church, and the old bakery.
- Lyngentrappa Staircase** 2-4 hrs return · Strenuous · Free — Start at the Lyngentrappa trailhead near the waterfront and climb 1,200 steps to the 468 m viewpoint 'Verdens Ende'.
