**Docking:** Pier — Frihamnen (Freeport), berths 601/602

**Walk to Center:** ~1.5 km / 15-20 min walk — easily walkable, or take the shuttle

**Best For:** Architecture, history, beaches, cross-border day trip to Copenhagen

**Don't Miss:** Turning Torso, Ribersborg beach sauna, Malmöhus Castle

## TOP THINGS TO DO

- Malmöhus Castle & Museums** — The oldest surviving Renaissance castle in the Nordic countries houses the Malmö Museum, an art collection, and a small...
- Västra Hamnen & Turning Torso** — Walk the Western Harbour's waterfront boardwalk past innovative sustainable architecture.
- Ribersborg Beach & Kallbadhus Sauna** — Malmö's beloved 2.5 km sandy beach is a short walk from the castle.
- Lilla Torg & Old Town Wander** — Malmö's little square is ringed by colourful 16th-century half-timbered houses and buzzing café terraces.
- Day Trip to Copenhagen** — Malmö's greatest party trick: Copenhagen is 35 minutes by train across the Öresund Bridge.

## BEST WALKS

- City Centre to Ribersborg Beach Loop** ~5 km | 1.5-2 hrs | Easy, flat — From Stortorget, head west through Kungsparken to Malmöhus Castle, then continue along the canal to Ribersborg beach for views of the...
- Lilla Torg to Västra Hamnen Waterfront** ~3 km one way | 1 hr | Easy — Stroll from Malmö's charming medieval square through the city to the award-winning sustainable Western Harbour district, with views of...

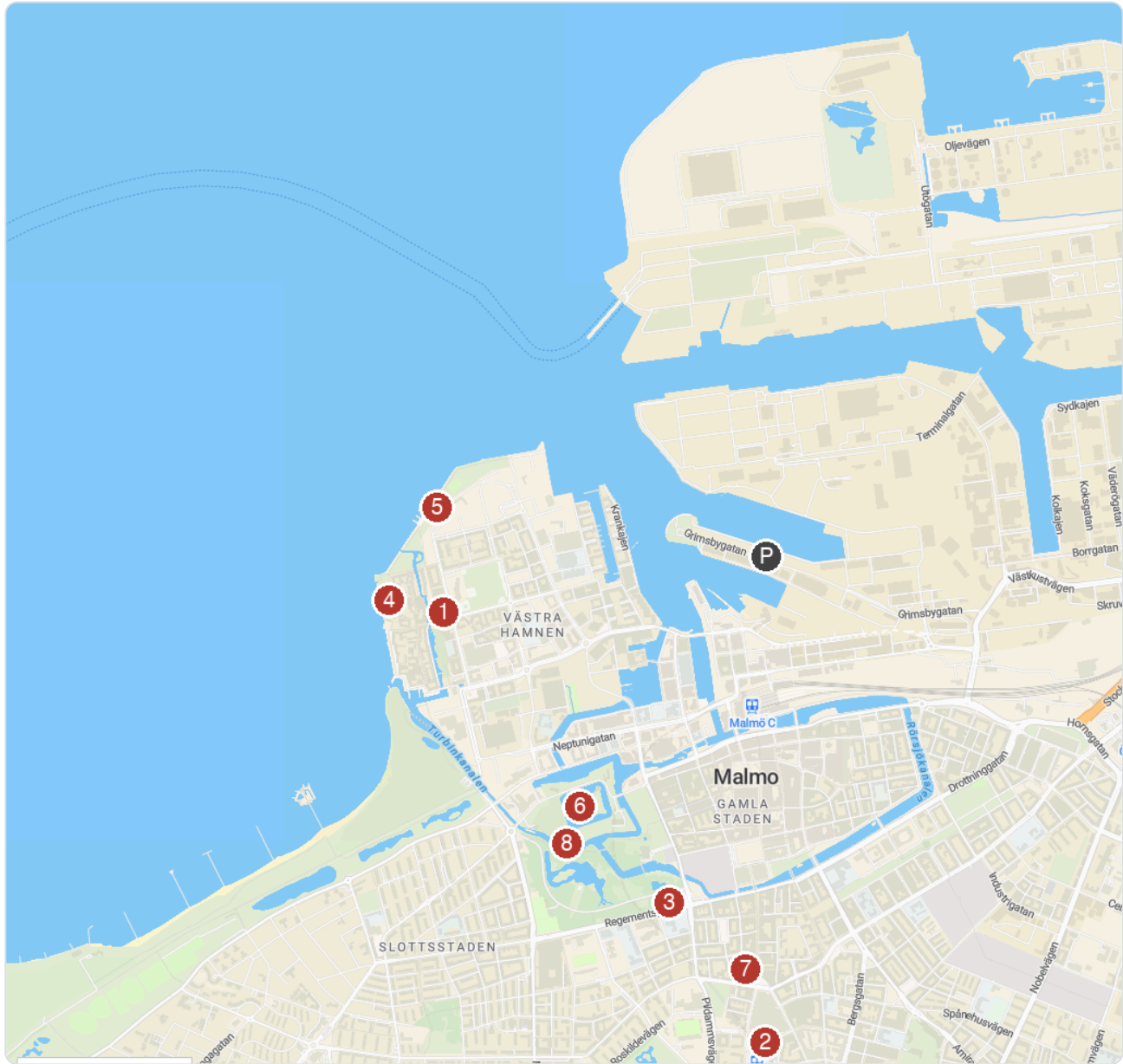
