Docking: Pier — New Mangalore Port (Panambur), ~10 km from city centre

Walk to Centre: Not walkable; shuttle or taxi required (port is industrial)

- **St. Aloysius Chapel & City Temples** — The Jesuit-built St.

- **Panambur Beach** — The closest beach to the port, just outside the port gates, with golden sand, jet ski and camel rides, and great street...
- **Tannirbhavi Beach & Sultan Battery** — A quieter pine-lined beach south of the river, reachable by car or a scenic ferry from the Sultan Battery — a compact...
- **Mangalorean Food & Market Walk** — Dive into one of India's most celebrated regional cuisines: Chicken Ghee Roast, Neer Dosa with coconut chutney, Kane...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town Temple & Chapel Walk** ~3 km | Easy | 1.5-2 hrs — From the city centre, walk to St.
- **Panambur Beach Stroll** ~2 km beachfront | Easy | 1 hr — A leisurely walk along Panambur Beach from the main entry point south along the shoreline.

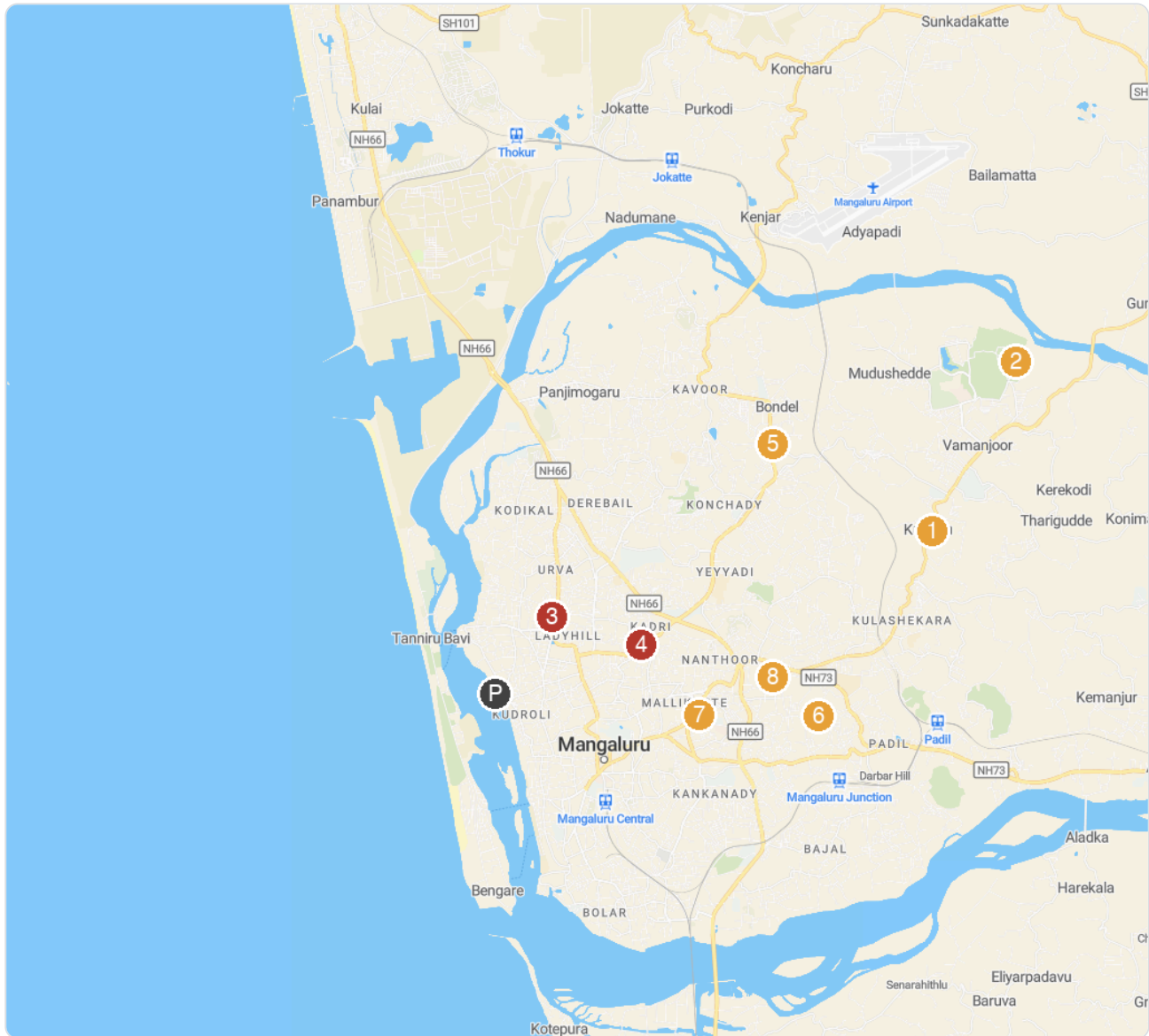
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Visa required: India does not offer visa-on-arrival for cruise passengers. Arrange an e-Visa or paper visa before your cruise. Print your e-Visa confirmation to show at...
- Carry cash in INR: Local temples, auto-rickshaws, street food, and small restaurants accept Indian Rupees only. Exchange at the port terminal kiosk before heading out.
- You can't walk out of the port: New Mangalore Port is a large industrial facility. Use the free shuttle to the gate or book a taxi
