Founded in 1788 as the first permanent American settlement in the Northwest Territory, Marietta pairs ancient Native American earthworks with golden-age steamboat lore—all within easy walking distance of the levee dock.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Campus Martius Museum** — Built on the original 1788 pioneer stockade site, this museum preserves the Rufus Putnam House — the oldest surviving...
- **Ohio River Museum & W.P. Snyder Jr.** — The last intact steam-powered sternwheel towboat in the US sits moored outside this museum dedicated to the golden age...
- **Mound Cemetery & Conus Mound** — An ancient conical burial mound—part of the Marietta Earthworks built by the Adena or Hopewell peoples—rises from...
- **The Castle Historic House Museum** — An 1855 Gothic Revival mansion with octagonal towers, Victorian gardens, and guided tours through the history of...
- **Harmar Village & Pedestrian Bridge** — Cross the historic Harmar Railroad Bridge — now a pedestrian swing bridge — to this neighborhood of brick streets...

BEST WALKS

- **Riverfront to Mound Cemetery Loop** 1.5 miles | ~45 min | Easy — From the levee, walk up Greene Street into downtown, browse Front Street's boutiques and Putnam Chocolate, then continue to Mound...
- **Lafayette Hotel to Campus Martius** 0.5 miles | ~20 min | Easy — Stop in the Lafayette Hotel lobby for steamboat memorabilia, then walk two blocks to Campus Martius Museum.

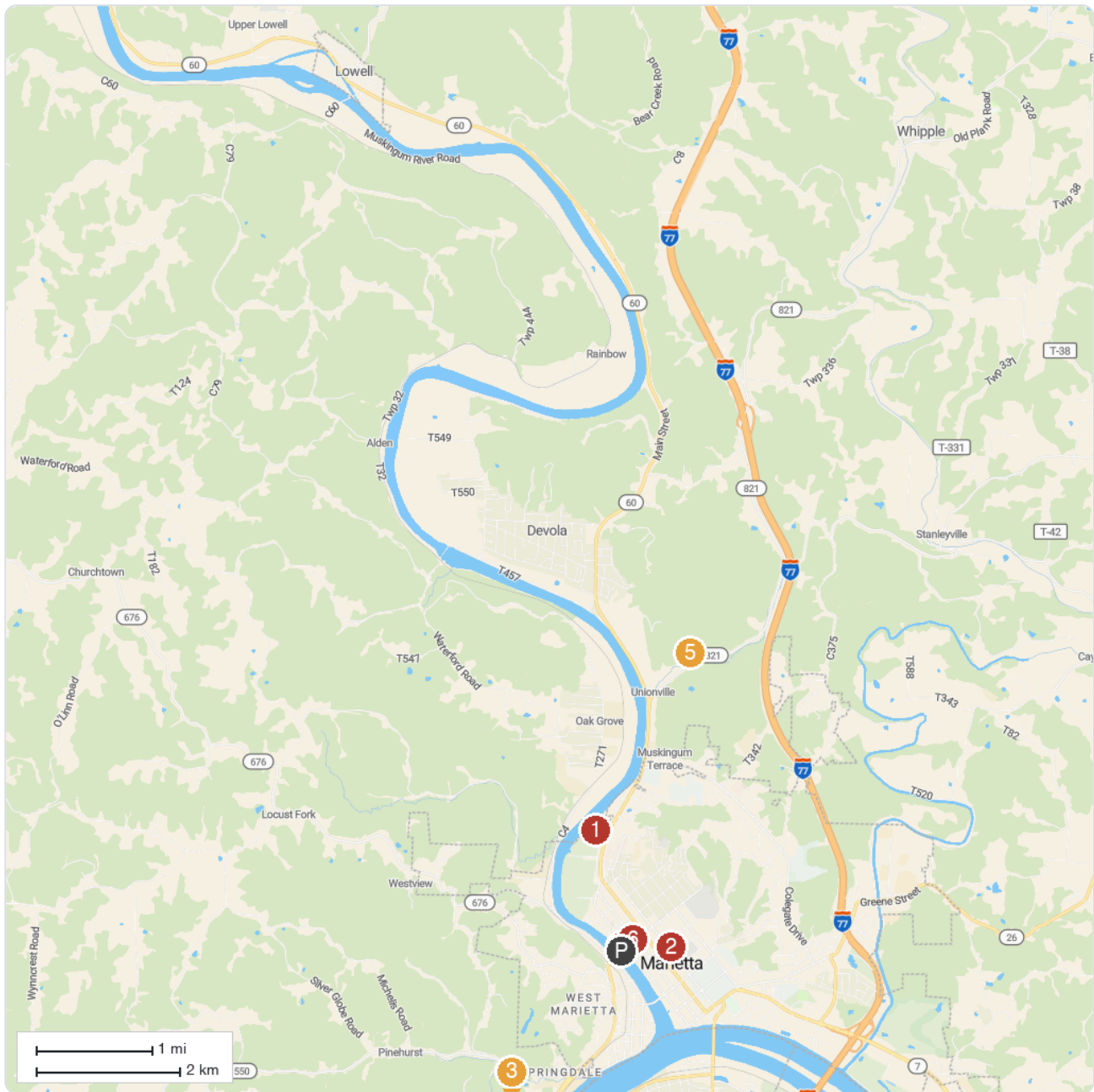
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Wear flat shoes. Brick and cobblestone sidewalks in parts of the historic district — heels are a bad idea.
- Use the ship's trolley for The Castle and outlying museums — American Cruise Lines provides a free loop. Ask at the gangway.
- Don't skip Putnam Chocolate on Front Street — handmade artisan truffles and a Marietta institution.
