TOP THINGS TO DO

- Pontevedra Medieval Old Town** — Pontevedra is internationally celebrated for banning cars from its entire historic center.
- Mogor Petroglyphs (Petroglifos de Mogor)** — One of Galicia's most significant prehistoric rock-art sites, the Mogor Labyrinth is carved into coastal outcrops...
- Coastal Walk to Portocelo & Mogor Beaches** — The Senda Azul coastal path links Marín town to its Blue Flag beaches — sheltered Portocelo (1.5 km) and...
- Combarro — Stone Granaries on the Water** — Fifteen kilometers up the ría, Combarro is a perfectly preserved fishing village famous for its hórreos — stone grain...
- Galician Seafood & Tapas in Pontevedra** — Galicia is Spain's seafood capital.

BEST WALKS

- Senda Azul to Portocelo Beach** 1.5 km · 20 min · Easy — From the port gate, follow the signed coastal footpath (Senda Azul) south along the ría to sheltered Portocelo beach.
- Town Center to Mogor Petroglyphs** 2.2 km · 30 min · Easy–moderate — Continue past Portocelo along the coastal path to the Mogor Petroglyphs — Bronze Age carvings with a free interpretation center.

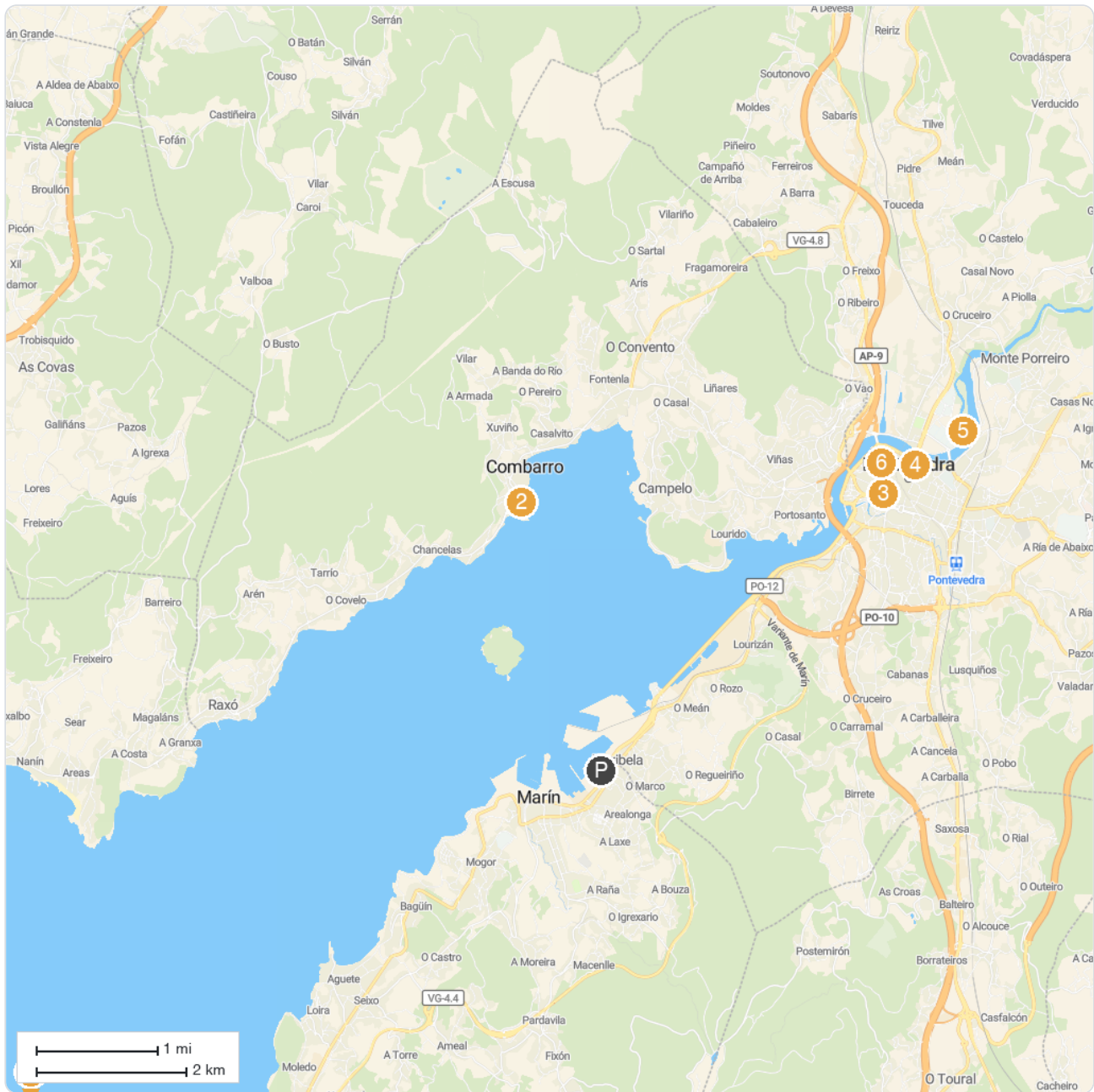
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bus to Pontevedra is the best value: Monbus leaves every 10–15 min from outside the port gate, costs under €2 each way, and drops you in Pontevedra's pedestrian heart. Skip the...
- Pack a light rain jacket: Galicia earns its nickname "Green Spain" — even in summer, brief showers are common. A compact waterproof keeps the day moving.
