GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Saline Bay jetty — no cruise pier exists

Walk to center: 15–20 min steep uphill from Saline Bay to Old Wall village

Best For: Beaches, snorkeling, off-the-grid Caribbean atmosphere

Don't Miss: Salt Whistle Bay beach and the church hilltop overlook of the Tobago Cays

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Tobago Cays Snorkel by Catamaran** — The uninhabited Tobago Cays are a UNESCO-protected marine park and the top reason many lines include Mayreau on their...
- **Salt Whistle Bay Beach Day** — A double-sided beach — powdery white sand curving between the calm Caribbean Sea and the windward Atlantic, fringed by...
- **Island Walk: Saline Bay to Salt Whistle Bay** — A cross-island walk along the one concrete road takes you up through the hilltop village of Old Wall, past the historic...
- **Old Wall Village & Church Overlook** — Climb to the hilltop village on Station Hill, site of the stone Church of the Immaculate Conception (consecrated 1930).
- **Rum Punch & Grilled Lobster at Dennis' Hideaway** — Dennis' Hideaway, perched on the hill overlooking Saline Bay, is a Mayreau institution — island hospitality, strong rum...

BEST WALKS

- **Saline Bay to Old Wall Village & Church** 20 min uphill | Moderate (steep) | Free — From the tender jetty at Saline Bay, follow the single concrete road uphill to the hilltop village on Station Hill.
- **Cross-Island Walk: Saline Bay to Salt Whistle Bay** 40–45 min total | Moderate | Free — Continue from the church downhill on the west side to reach Salt Whistle Bay — the island's crown jewel double-sided beach.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Cash only, no ATMs. There are no banks or ATMs on Mayreau. Bring USD — vendors, beach bars, shuttles, and local restaurants all operate cash only. EC dollars are the local...
- Note the last tender time. Cell service is nearly nonexistent and there are no taxis. If you miss the tender window, you're stranded. Check the posted return time before heading...
- Wear walking shoes, not flip-flops. The road from Saline Bay to the village is steep concrete in direct sun. Sandals are fine for the beach, but you'll regret them on the climb.
