GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Direct alongside at Quai Jacques Prévert / Quai Sadi Carnot on the Marne — no tender

Walk to centre: 5–10 min flat walk to Cathedral & Jardin Bossuet

Best For: History lovers, foodies, day-trippers to Paris (~35 min by train)

Don't Miss: Brie de Meaux tasting + Musée de la Grande Guerre (WWI museum)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Musée de la Grande Guerre** — The largest WWI museum in Europe sits just outside Meaux, on the ground where the First Battle of the Marne was fought...
- **Cathédrale Saint-Étienne & Episcopal Quarter** — A masterpiece of Gothic architecture built from the 12th to 16th centuries, the cathedral contains the tomb of...
- **Brie de Meaux Tasting & Maison du Brie** — Meaux is the birthplace of the 'King of Cheeses'.
- **Musée Bossuet (Episcopal Palace)** — Occupying the 12th-century Bishop's Palace beside the cathedral, this museum displays 17th- and 18th-century paintings...
- **Day Trip to Paris by Train** — Meaux's train station is 10 minutes from the dock.

BEST WALKS

- **Episcopal Quarter Loop** 1.5 km · 25–30 min · Flat · Historic — From the Marne quay, walk up to Place Henri IV, then to Cathédrale Saint-Étienne, through Jardin Bossuet, along the Gallo-Roman...
- **Marne Riverside & Parc du Pâtis** 2–3 km · 40 min · Flat · Nature — Head downstream (south) along the Marne towpath to reach Parc Naturel du Pâtis — a 150-hectare park with lakes, wildflower meadows...

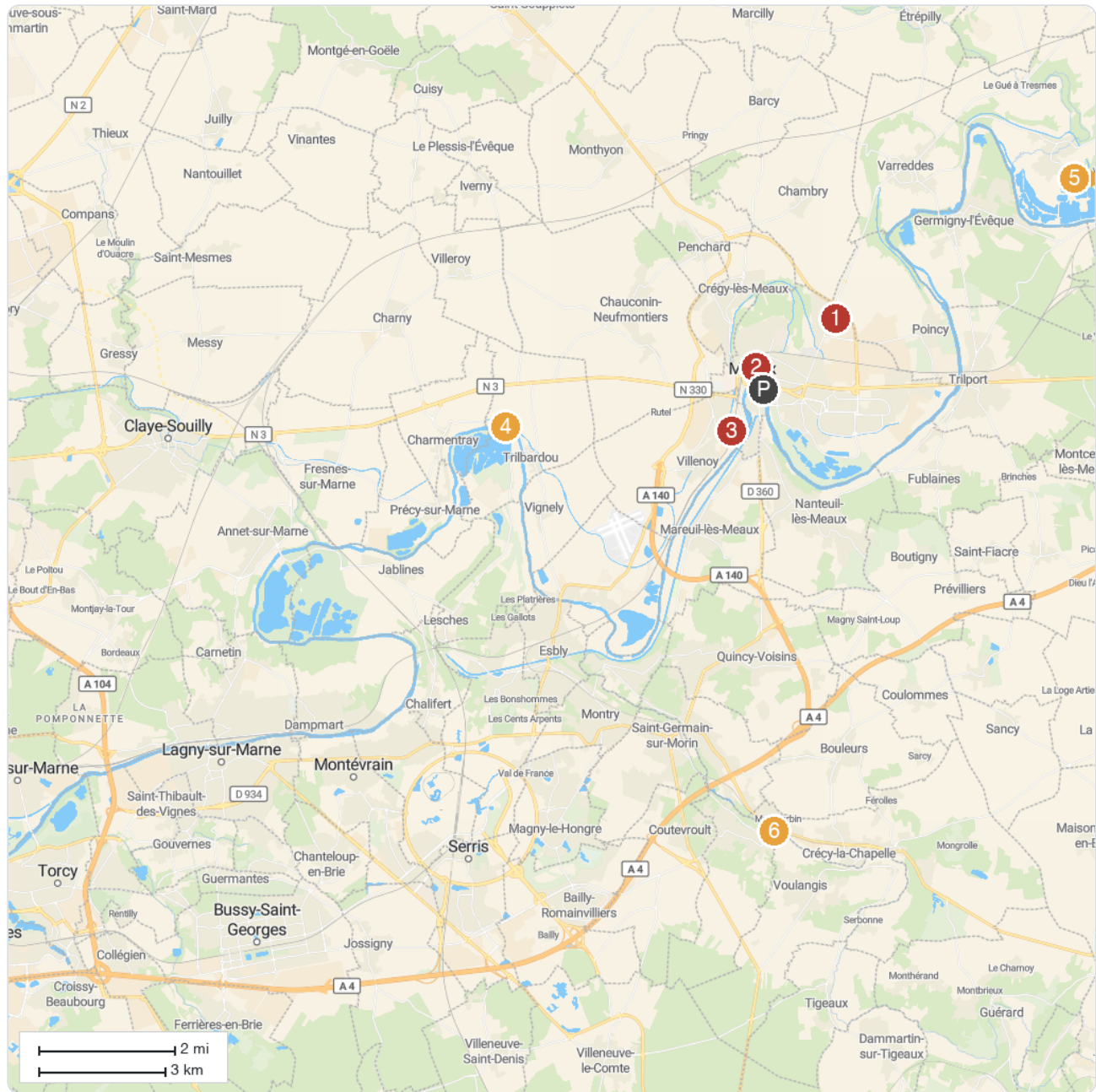
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
