

Mělník, Czech Republic

Perched on a vineyard hill above the confluence of the Elbe and Vltava rivers, Mělník is a Bohemian wine town crowned by a Lobkowicz château — a relaxed, scenic stop just 35 km downstream from Prague.

GETTING ASHORE

Getting There: Ship docks on the Elbe at Mělník; the old town sits on the hill above the landing

Walk to Center: ~10-15 min uphill from the riverside landing to the château and town square

Best For: Wine tasting, Baroque château, river views, easy day trips to Prague

Don't Miss: Mělník Château terrace over the river confluence & a tasting of Ludmila wine



Getting around: **Taxi** 80–130 CZK (~6 USD) · **Rideshare** Bolt

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Mělník Château (Lobkowicz)** — The Baroque château crowning the town has been the seat of the Lobkowicz family, returned to them in 1992 after...
- **Château Wine Cellars & Tasting** — Beneath the château run historic cellars that store the estate's Bohemian wines.
- **Church of Sts. Peter and Paul & Confluence View** — Beside the château stands the Gothic Church of Sts.
- **Day Trip to Prague** — Just ~35 km upstream, Prague is an easy coach excursion from Mělník.

BEST WALKS

- **Château Hill & Old Town Walk** ~1.5 km · 30-45 min · uphill cobblestones — From the riverside landing, climb the vineyard slope to the château and the Church of Sts.
- **Vineyard Slopes Stroll** ~1 km · 20-30 min · gentle slope — Wander the terraced vineyards below the château — including the St.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Taste the local wine. Mělník is one of Bohemia's two wine regions. The château cellars and town wine bars pour Riesling, Pinot Noir, and the Ludmila label — a tradition Charles IV...
- Currency: the Czech Republic uses the Czech Koruna (CZK), not the Euro. Cards are widely accepted; carry a little cash for small cafés and the church tower.
- Expect a climb. The old town sits on a hill above the river — the walk up is short but on cobblestones and stone. Comfortable
