- **Pembroke Castle** — Birthplace of King Henry VII and one of Wales' greatest medieval fortresses, with a massive circular Norman keep and...
- **Tenby Walled Town & Harbour** — Pastel-painted Georgian houses inside 13th-century walls, a working harbour, golden beaches, and boat trips to Caldey...
- **St Davids Cathedral & Bishop's Palace** — The UK's smallest city hides a stunning 12th-century cathedral and the atmospheric ruins of the Bishop's Palace.
- **Skomer Island Puffins** — Britain's most accessible puffin colony — boat trips from Martin's Haven (near Marloes) put you within metres of...
- **Pembrokeshire Coast Path** — Join the 186-mile national trail straight from the marina.

BEST WALKS

- **Milford Waterfront & Marina Stroll** 30-45 min · Flat · Free — From the Mackerel Stage pontoon, walk the length of the waterfront past boutique shops, Foam café, the Milford Haven Museum, and the...
- **The Rath Park & Harbour Views** 45-60 min · Moderate (uphill) · Free — Head uphill from the marina to The Rath, a grassy elevated park with war memorials and panoramic views across the Milford Haven...

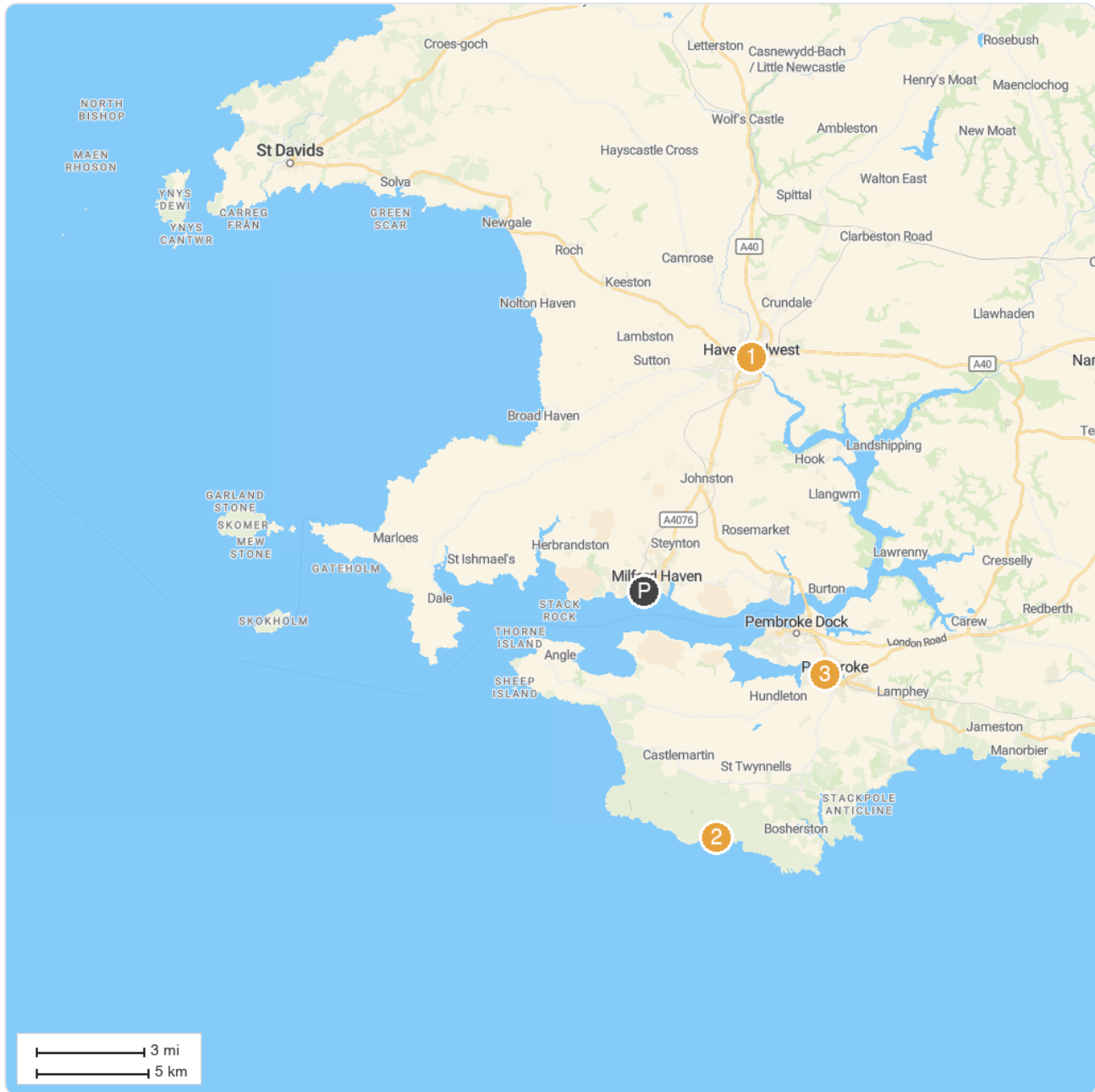
