Docking: River pier on the Main — no tendering, steps from the old town

Walk to center: 3–5 min to Schnatterloch market square

Best For: Medieval architecture, beer & wine, leisurely strolls

Don't Miss: Gasthaus Zum Riesen — Germany's oldest royal inn (documented 1411)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Old Town & Schnatterloch Walking Tour** — Explore the Schnatterloch market square with its 1583 Renaissance fountain, the Hauptstraße lined with 14th–17th...
 - **Mildenburg Castle & Museum** — Hike 15 minutes uphill from the market square to this 12th-century castle for panoramic views of the Main River loop.
- **Faust Brewery Beer Garden** — Miltenberg's family-owned Brauhaus Faust sits right on the river.
 - **Museum Stadt Miltenberg** — Housed in a handsome Renaissance building on the Schnatterloch, this museum covers the town's Roman roots, medieval...
 - **Main River Cycle Route** — Miltenberg sits on the Main-Radweg, one of Germany's most scenic flat bike paths.

BEST WALKS

- **River Promenade to Schnatterloch & St. Jakobus** 1.5 km · 30 min · Easy · Flat, some cobbles — Start at the river dock and stroll the Mainpromenade before heading into the old town via the Mainzer Tor gate.
- **Castle Hill Walk** 2 km round trip · 45 min · Moderate · Uphill trail — From the Schnatterloch, follow the wooded path up to Mildenburg Castle for sweeping views over the Main River bend.

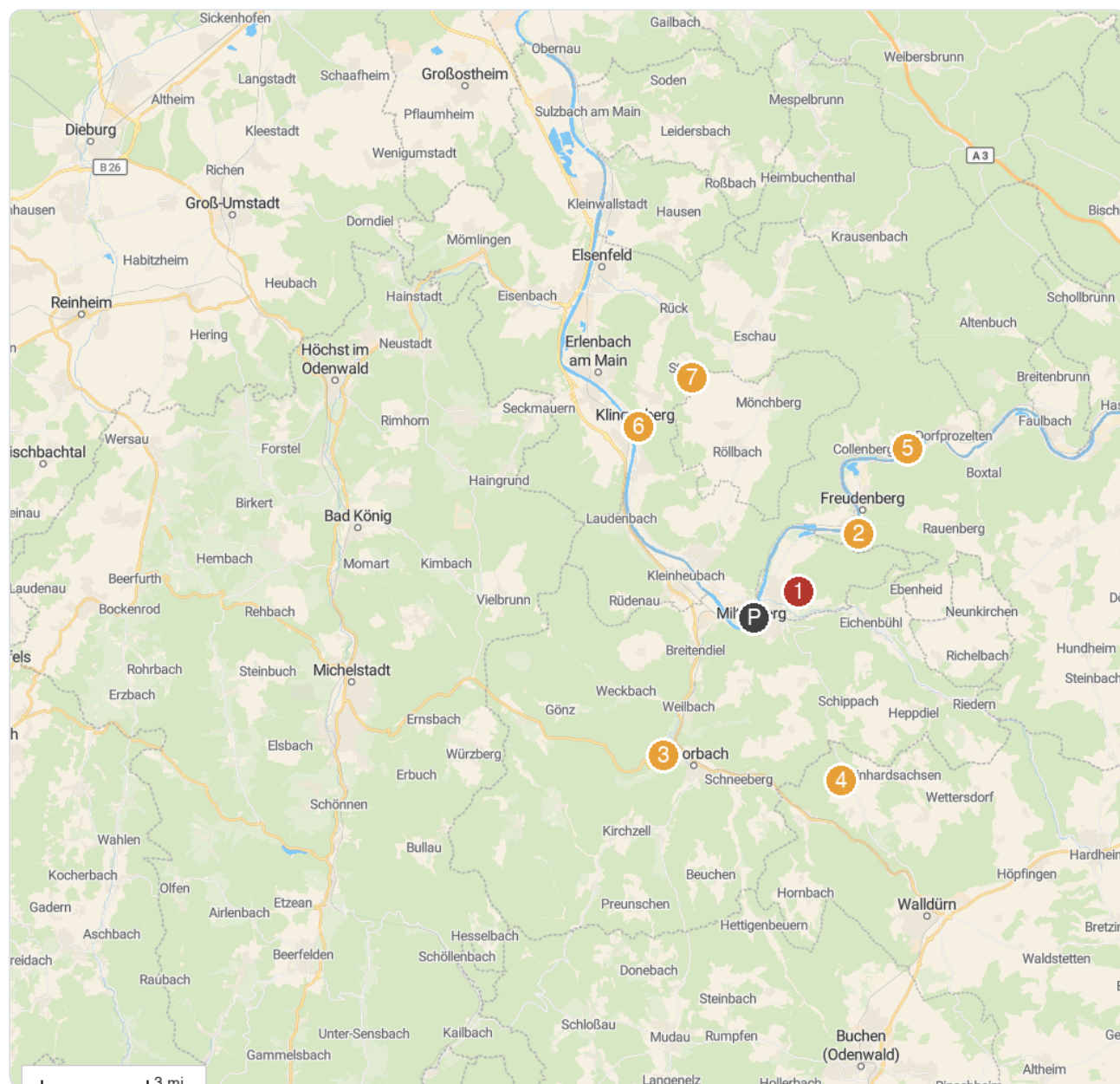
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
