Docking: Pier — no tender. Pier Wisconsin (downtown) or Jones Island Heavy Lift Dock (south, shuttle required)

Walk to center: 2 min from Pier Wisconsin; Jones Island requires a ~15-min rideshare or cruise shuttle

- **Milwaukee Art Museum & the Calatrava Wings** — One of the most spectacular museum buildings in the world — Santiago Calatrava's Quadracci Pavilion features 217-foot... entertaining, with souvenir pint...
- **Harley-Davidson Museum** — Even non-riders find this 20-acre campus compelling.
- **Pabst Mansion & Old World Third Street** — Tour the gilded Flemish Renaissance mansion of beer baron Captain Frederick Pabst, then stroll Old World Third Street...
- **Lakefront Brewery Tour** — Consistently rated one of the best brewery tours in America — irreverent, fast, and
- **Bradford Beach & the Lakefront Path** — Lake Michigan looks and feels like an ocean — miles of horizon, soft sand, and waves.

BEST WALKS

- **Lakefront Landmark Loop** 2.5 miles · Easy · 60-90 min — Walk north from Pier Wisconsin past the Milwaukee Art Museum to Veterans Park and Bradford Beach, then cut inland to the Bronze Fonz...
- **Riverwalk Stroll** 1.5 miles · Easy · 45 min — Follow the Milwaukee RiverWalk from the Third Ward north through downtown.

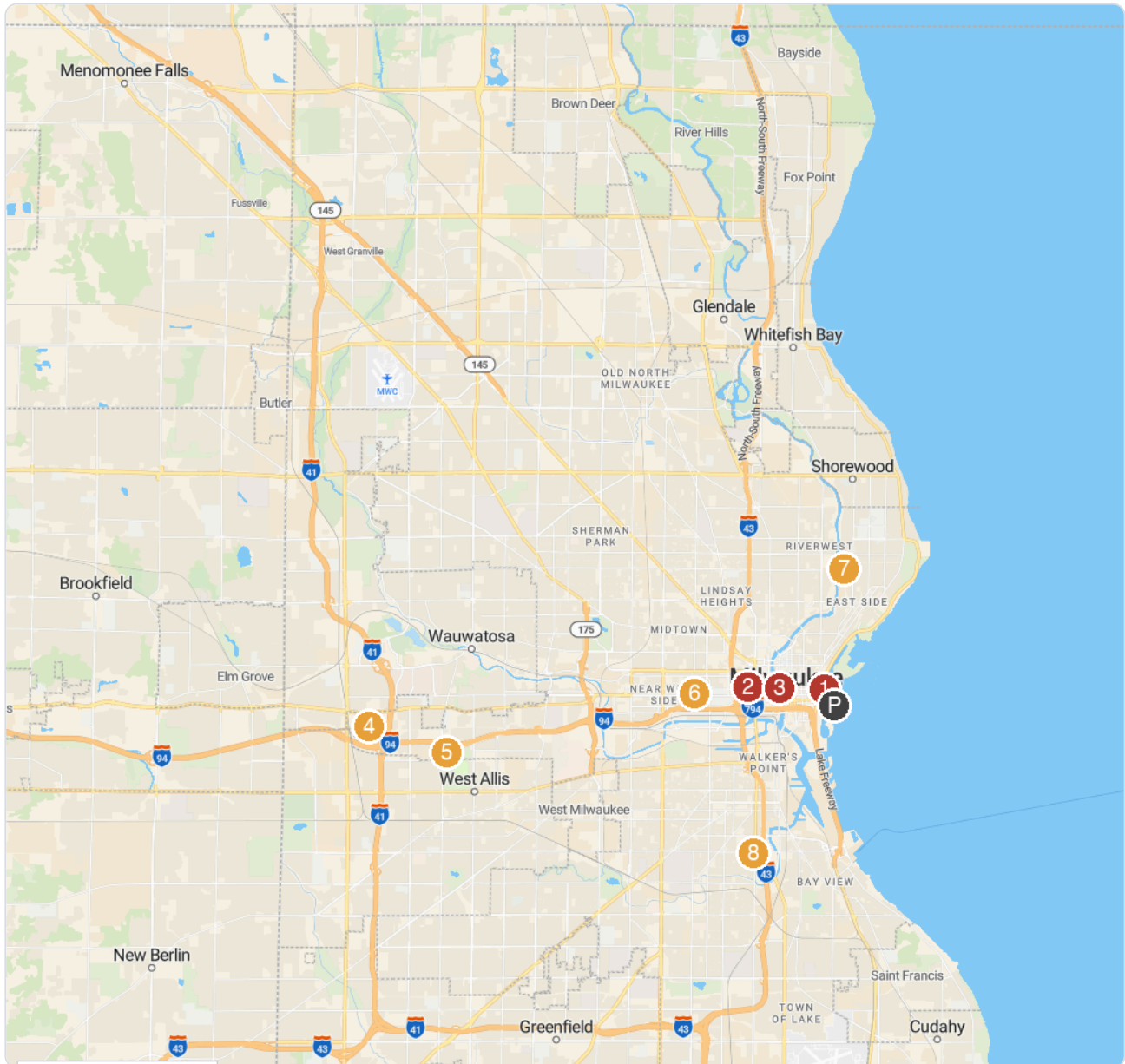
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
