Norway's 'Town of Roses' sits on the Romsdalsfjord beneath 222 snow-capped peaks. Ships dock right in town, putting cafés, museums, and a legendary mountain panorama within easy walking distance.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Varden Viewpoint — The Molde Panorama** — Hike or ride to 407 m above sea level for Norway's most famous fjord panorama: 222 partially snow-capped peaks above...
- Atlantic Ocean Road Drive** — One of the world's most dramatic roads — 8.3 km hopping between islands via eight bridges, including the iconic curved...
- Romsdal Folk Museum (Romsdalsmuseet)** — One of Norway's largest open-air folk museums, with 40+ historic turf-roofed buildings from the 16th–20th centuries and...
- WWII Royal Birch Monument** — In 1940, King Haakon VII and Crown Prince Olav sheltered under a birch tree as German bombers attacked Molde.
- Retiro Beach & Fjordside Walk** — Molde's sandy beach sits in a sheltered cove 2.5 km east of the pier, with picnic areas and fjord views.

BEST WALKS

- Town Centre & Rose Garden Loop** 1–1.5 hrs · Easy · Free — Walk from the pier to the town square (Torget), then to Molde Cathedral and its rose gardens, and on to the Town Hall roof garden...
- Varden Panorama Hike** 2–2.5 hrs return · Moderate · Free — Follow the 'Green Corridor' (Grønn Løype) trail uphill from near the Romsdal Museum to the Varden viewpoint at 407 m.
