TOP THINGS TO DO

- **St. Mary's Church & Müntzer Memorial** — The tallest spire in Thuringia marks St.
- **Divi Blasii Church — Bach's Early Organ** — Johann Sebastian Bach served as organist here in 1707–08, composing some of his earliest cantatas including BWV 71.
- **Medieval City Wall Walk** — Walk a 370-metre section of the almost entirely intact 2.2 km city wall — one of Germany's best-preserved.
- **Peasants' War Museum (Kornmarktkirche)** — Housed in the former Corn Market Church, this museum dives deep into the German Peasants' War of 1525 — the largest...
- **Old Town Self-Guided Walk** — Stroll Linsenstraße, the Untermarkt, and around the Town Hall to admire half-timbered houses, Gothic facades, and the...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town Loop** 2 km · ~45 min · flat cobblestones — From the Frauentor gate, walk through the Altstadt to Untermarkt, past the Town Hall, along Linsenstraße, then back via Divi Blasii...
- **City Wall Walk** 370 m walkable section · ~30 min · some stairs — Follow the signposted path along the medieval fortifications between the Frauentor and the Rabenturm for rooftop views over the old...

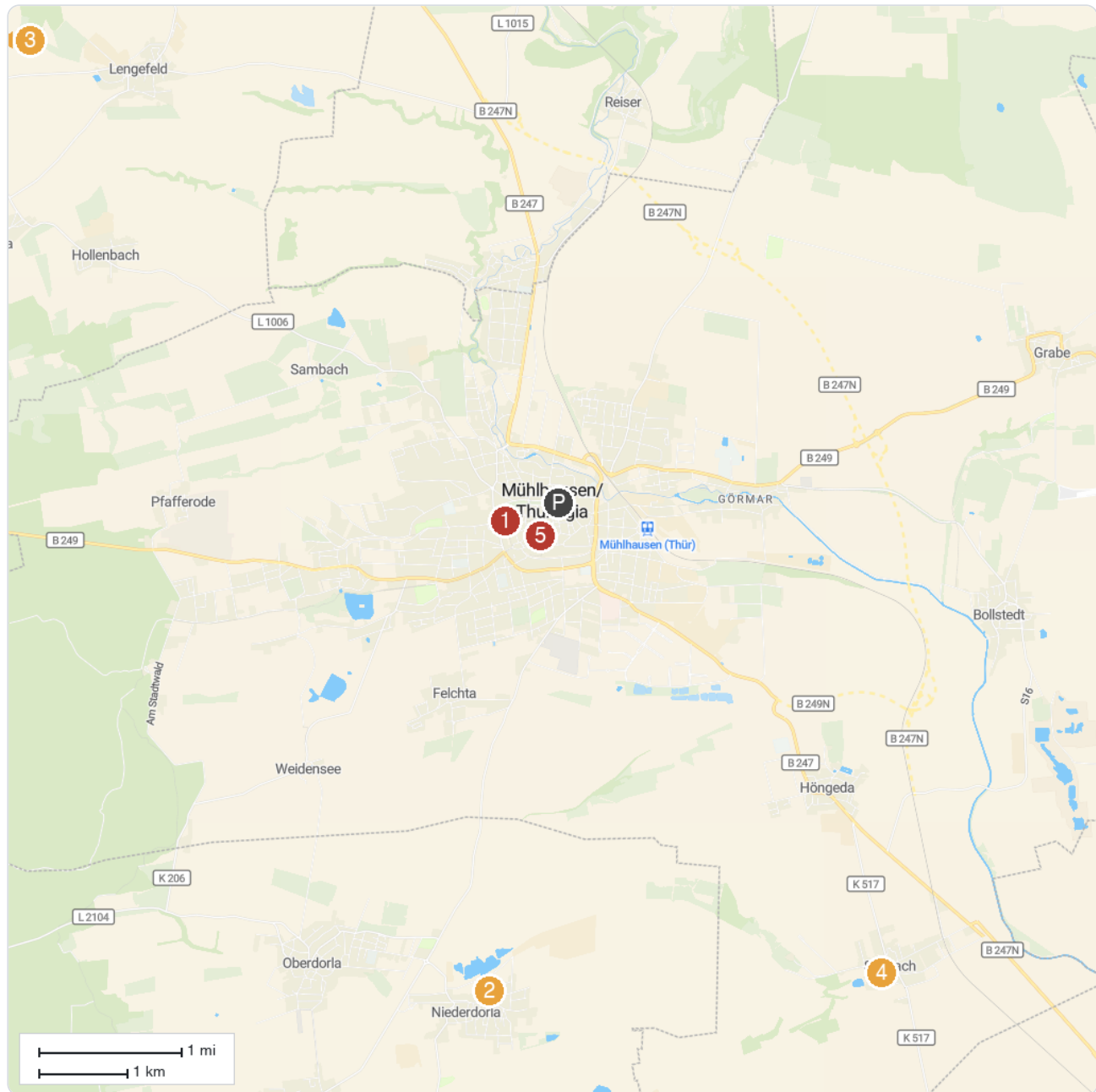
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Cash only at many sites. Church entrances, the city wall walk, and street food vendors typically don't take cards. Bring Euros.
- Cobblestones everywhere. The entire old town is historic stone paving — flat but uneven. Skip heels; wear solid walking shoes.
- Try a Thüringer Rostbratwurst. Thuringia's famous marjoram-spiced sausage grilled over charcoal is sold at street stalls and is the essential local bite.
