TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Nagoya Castle & Hommaru Palace** — The reconstructed Hommaru Palace inside the castle grounds is a masterpiece of Edo-period craftsmanship — gold-leaf...
- **Toyota Commemorative Museum of Industry & Technology** — Housed in the original red-brick textile factory where Toyota began, this world-class museum traces the company from...
- **SCMAGLEV and Railway Park** — 39 real trains including record-breaking superconducting maglev vehicles, steam locomotives, and Shinkansen.
- **Atsuta Jingu Shrine** — One of Japan's most sacred Shinto shrines, said to enshrine the Kusanagi legendary sword (one of three Imperial Regalia).
- **Nagoya Meshi Food Tour — Osu District** — Nagoya has Japan's most distinctive regional food culture.

BEST WALKS

- **Sakae & Osu Loop** 2–3 km · Easy · City center — From Sakae Station, admire the futuristic Oasis 21 structure with its elevated water deck, then walk south to the Osu Kannon temple...
- **Nagoya Castle Grounds** 1–2 km · Easy · Historic — Enter through the east gate, explore the Ninomaru Garden, then spend most time inside the Hommaru Palace.
