TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Country Music Hall of Fame & Museum** — The world's largest popular music museum houses millions of artifacts — stage costumes, instruments, and memorabilia...
- **Ryman Auditorium Tour** — The 'Mother Church of Country Music' — former home of the Grand Ole Opry since 1943.
- **Johnny Cash & Patsy Cline Museums** — Two intimate, well-researched museums share a building on 3rd Ave.
- **Nashville Hot Chicken on Broadway** — Nashville's signature dish — cayenne-battered fried chicken with heat levels from mild to 'shut the cluck up.' Hattie...
- **Lower Broadway Honky Tonks** — Live country music starts at 10 AM and runs until 3 AM in the neon-lit bars of Lower Broadway.

BEST WALKS

- **Broadway & the Music Corridor** 1.2 miles round-trip | Easy | 45–60 min — Walk from the dock up to Broadway, stroll the honky tonk strip west to the Country Music Hall of Fame, then loop back via the Music...
- **Riverfront to Seigenthaler Bridge** 0.8 miles round-trip | Easy | 30 min — Walk south along the riverfront path to the John Seigenthaler Pedestrian Bridge for the best panoramic views of the Nashville skyline...

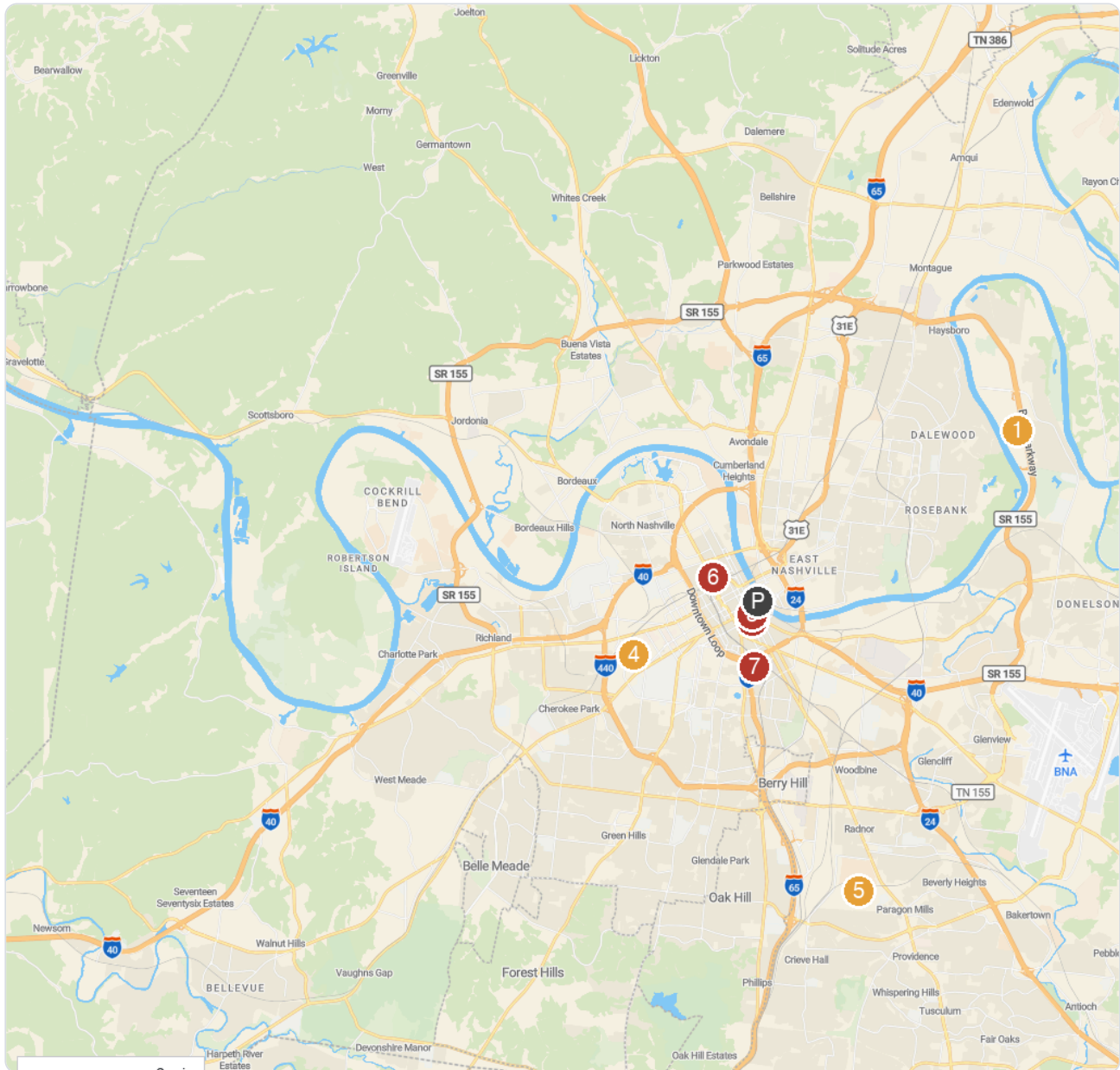
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
