GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships dock directly at the Natchez riverfront (Silver Street / Harbor View Dr) — no tender required

Best For: Antebellum mansion tours, Civil War history, Southern food & live music

Walk to center: Flat riverfront 5 min walk; steep 0.3-mile hill climb to historic downtown (shuttles provided)

Don't Miss: Longwood octagonal mansion, Natchez City Cemetery Turning Angel, Fat Mama's Tamales

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Antebellum Mansion Trail** — Tour Longwood (the largest octagonal house in the US, frozen mid-construction since 1861), Stanton Hall (Greek Revival...
- **William Johnson House & NPS Sites** — Explore the National Park Service–run William Johnson House, home of a free Black businessman whose diary gives a rare...
- **Natchez Bluff Park Walk** — Stroll the paved bluff-top paths for unobstructed panoramas of the Mississippi River.
- **Natchez Trace Parkway Terminus** — Natchez is the southern end of the 444-mile Natchez Trace Parkway, a historic forest corridor used by Native Americans...
- **Southern Food & Riverfront Drinks** — Hit Under-the-Hill Saloon (one of the oldest bars on the Mississippi) right near the ship, then head uptown for Fat...

BEST WALKS

- **Riverfront to Downtown Natchez** 1.2 miles • Moderate (steep hill) • 25–40 min — Walk off the gangway along Silver Street, then climb the bluff road to Main Street and the historic downtown.
- **Historic Downtown Loop** 1 mile • Easy (flat on top) • 20–30 min — From the shuttle drop-off, walk along Main Street past Stanton Hall, St.

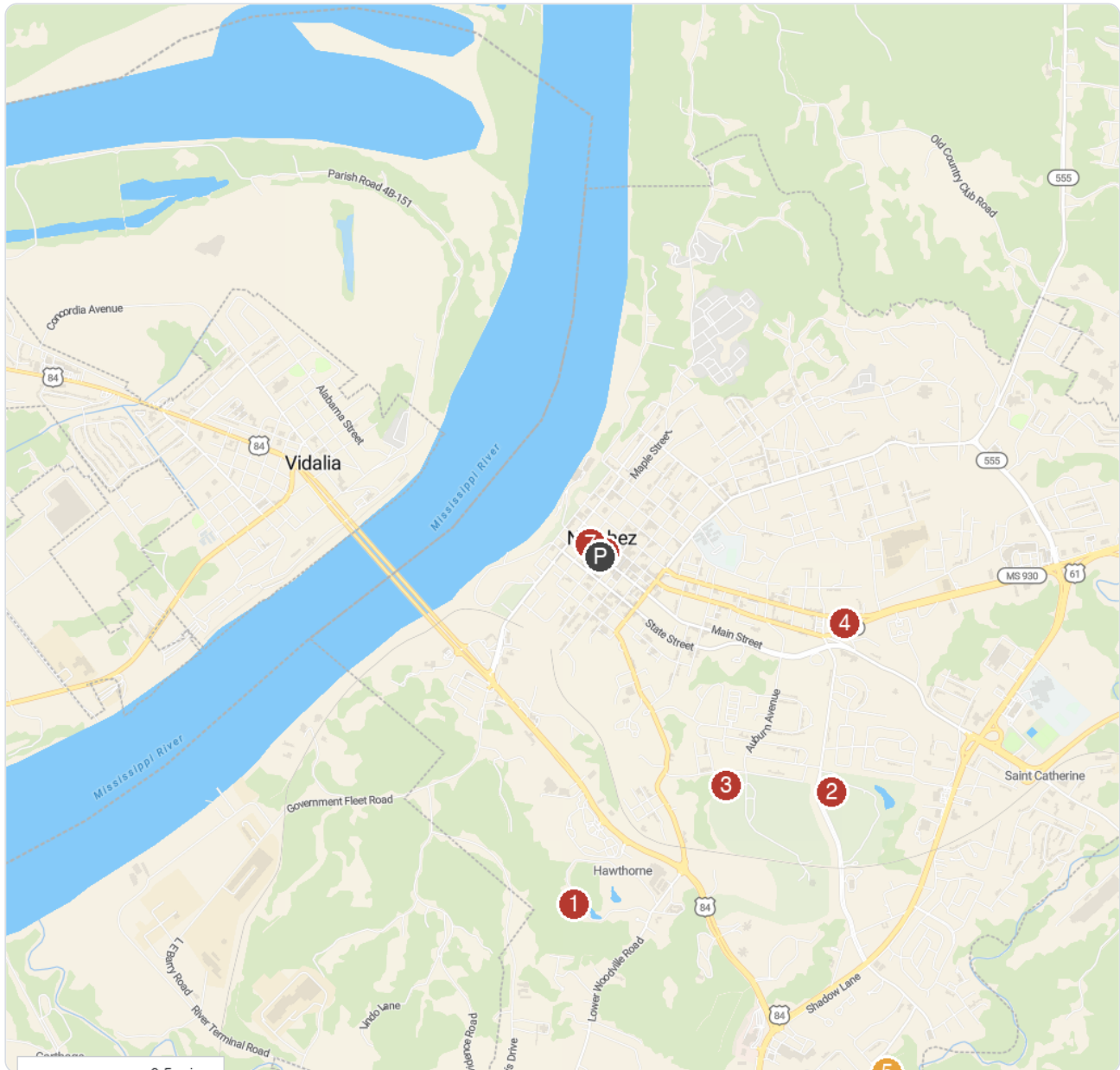
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use the shuttle. The Silver Street climb is steep and exhausting in summer heat. Most river cruise lines provide free hop-on-hop-off shuttles — use them, especially on the way...
- Summer heat is brutal. May–September is hot and extremely humid. Light clothing, a hat, and plenty of water are essential.
