GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in Klek-Neum Bay; 5-10 min boat ride to pier

Best For: Day trips to Mostar, budget seafood, curious history

Walk to center: Immediate — promenade begins at the tender dock

Don't Miss: Ćevapi lunch on the promenade; Mostar's Old Bridge

Getting around: **Taxi** 10–20 KM (~\$5–11 USD) · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Mostar & Stari Most** — The UNESCO-listed Old Bridge of Mostar is one of the Balkans' most stunning sights.
- **Kravice Waterfalls** — A stunning natural amphitheater of cascading falls emptying into an emerald swimming lake.
- **Ston & Mali Ston (Croatia)** — Cross into Croatia to see Europe's longest medieval walls and the oyster farms of Mali Ston Bay.
- **Medugorje Pilgrimage** — One of Catholicism's most visited pilgrimage sites, where apparitions of the Virgin Mary were reported in 1981.
- **Vjetrenica Cave** — Bosnia's most important cave system features large chambers, underground rivers, and nearly 200 subterranean species.

BEST WALKS

- **Promenade & Town Stroll** 2 km · Flat · 30-45 min — Walk the full length of the seafront promenade from the municipal pier past restaurants, souvenir stalls, and beach access points to...
- **Stari Neum & Illyrian Fort** 1.5 km uphill · Moderate · 45 min — Climb the steep streets behind the resort strip to reach old Neum's stone houses, the Church of St.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Euros work everywhere. The official currency is the Bosnian Mark (BAM), but restaurants, shops, and taxis all accept euros. Card payment is common at restaurants; carry a little...
- Data roaming warning. Bosnia is outside the EU — your EU roaming plan likely won't work here. Turn off mobile data before leaving the ship or buy a local eSIM.
