TOP THINGS TO DO

- The Caves Snorkel (Treasure Point)** — Three semi-submerged sea caves cut into the cliffs at the western edge of The Bight.
- The Indians Snorkel & Dive** — Four jagged rock pinnacles off Pelican Island, just northwest of Norman Island, rise from the seabed and plunge to...
- Spyglass Hill Hike** — Follow the dirt trail from The Bight beach up to the ridge where pirates once scanned for incoming Spanish galleons.
- The Willy T Floating Bar** — A roughly 100-foot former steel supply ship permanently anchored in The Bight, converted into a rowdy floating bar and...
- Pirates Bight Beach Day** — The beachfront restaurant right on The Bight offers lounge chairs (for rent), Caribbean and international cuisine...

BEST WALKS

- The Bight Beach Stroll** 0.5 km · Flat · 10 min — Walk the crescent of white sand from the tender dock west to the base of the Spyglass Hill trail.
- Spyglass Hill Trail** ~1.5 km round trip · Moderate · 50 min — From Pirates Bight restaurant, pick up the trail heading uphill through dry scrub.

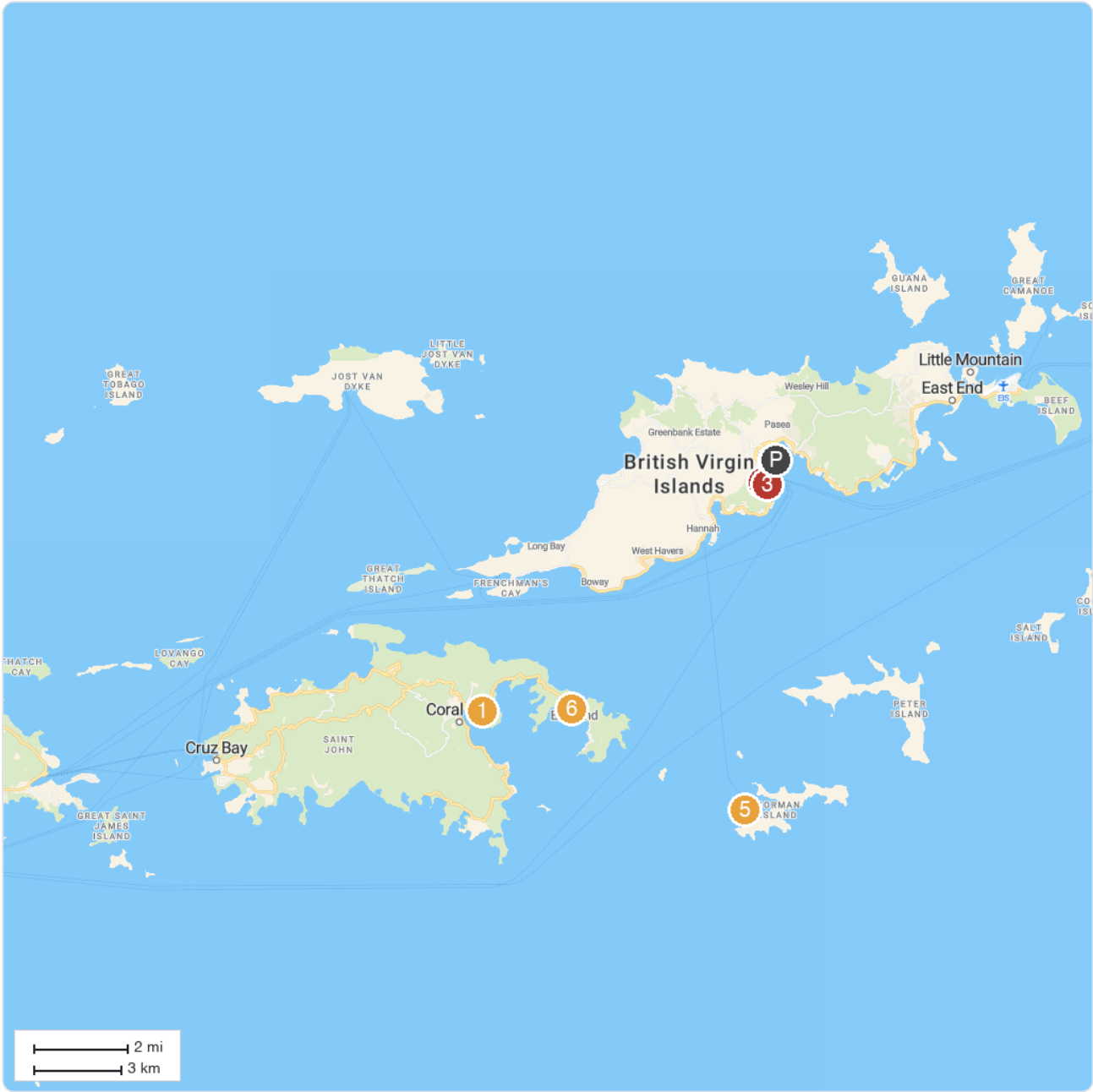
