GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Docked at the city-center quay (Kej žrtava racije) — no tender

Walk to center: ~10–15 min to Liberty Square (800 m flat)

Best For: History, architecture, Danube views, local food & wine

Don't Miss: Petrovaradin Fortress clock tower and underground galleries

Getting around: Taxi €5–€12 · Rideshare CarGo, Yandex Go

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Petrovaradin Fortress & Underground Galleries** — The 18th-century 'Gibraltar of the Danube' was never conquered.
 - Novi Sad Old Town Walk** — Liberty Square with its neo-Gothic Name of Mary Church and neo-Renaissance City Hall, plus Zmaj Jovina pedestrian...
 - Vojvodina Food & Bermet Wine Tasting** — Sample čevapi with kajmak, spicy riblja čorba (river fish soup), and Bermet
- the sweet Fruška Gora wine reportedly...

 - Fruška Gora National Park & Monasteries** — Rolling wine country 20 km from the dock, dotted with Orthodox monasteries, vineyards, and forested trails.
 - Štrand River Beach** — One of Europe's finest sandy river beaches stretches 700 m along the Danube — lounge chairs, beach bars, volleyball...

BEST WALKS

- Danube Park to Liberty Square** 1 km · 15 min · Flat — Stroll from the dock through Danube Park past the swan pond, then up Dunavska Street to Liberty Square with its church and city hall.
- Liberty Square to Petrovaradin Fortress** 1.5 km · 25 min · Moderate climb — From Liberty Square walk to Varadin Bridge, cross the Danube, and climb the cobblestone ramp to the fortress plateau.

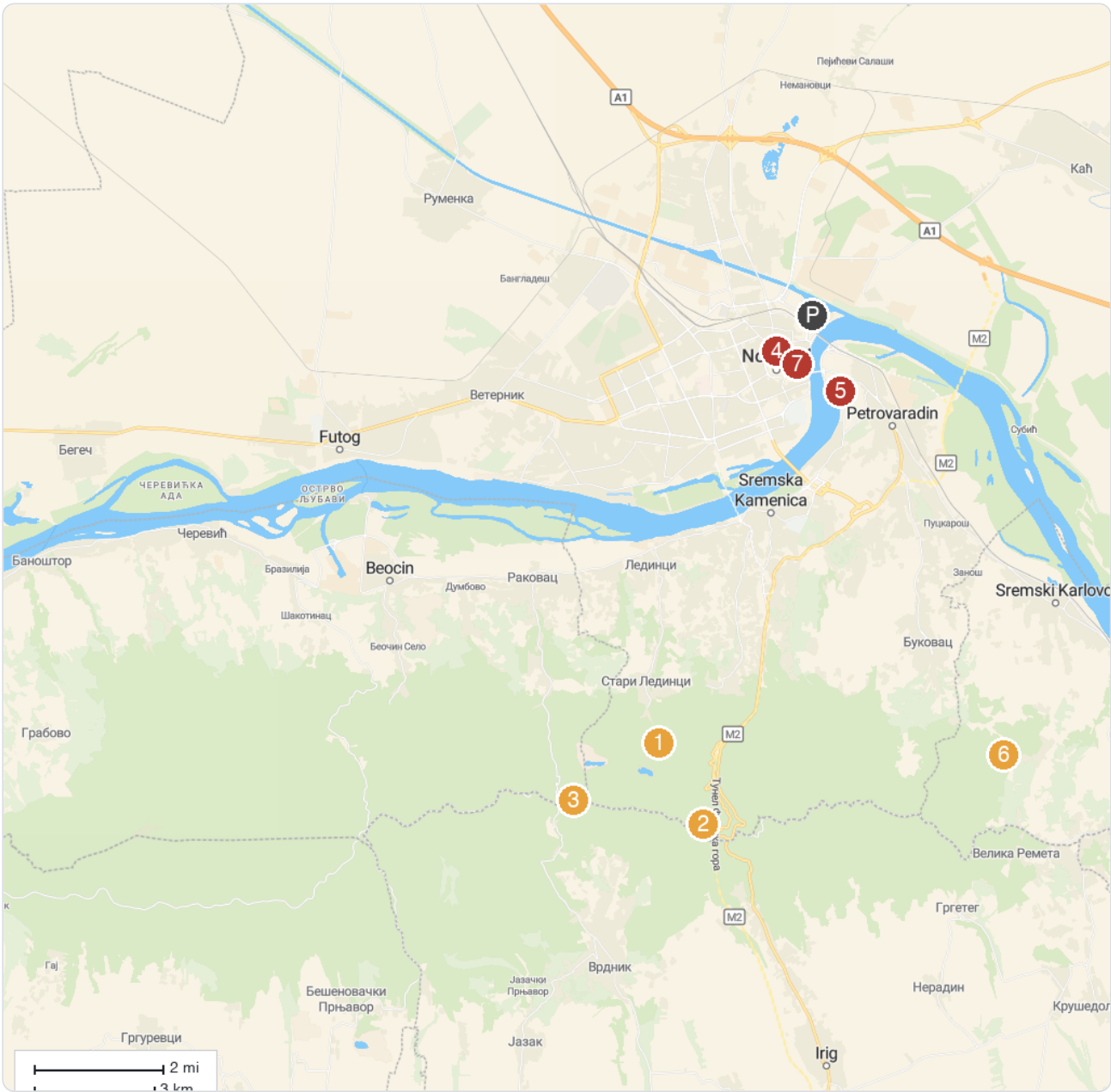
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use dinars, not euros. Serbia is not in the EU. Stalls may accept euros but give change in dinars at a poor rate. ATMs are plentiful; Visa/Mastercard accepted almost everywhere.
- Taxis are very cheap — \$3–4 USD to Štrand beach. Only use marked taxis with a roof company sign and insist on the meter
