

Nuku'alofa, Tongatapu, Tonga

Capital of the world's last Polynesian Kingdom, Nuku'alofa moves at pure island pace — free-roaming pigs, a Victorian royal palace, and volcanic blowholes shooting plumes 30 metres into the air await just minutes from the pier.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Vuna Wharf — docked, steps from city centre

Walk to centre: 5 min to Royal Palace; 10 min to Talamahu Market

Best For: Polynesian culture, royal history, blowholes, island day-trips

Don't Miss: Mapu 'a Vaea Blowholes on the south coast

Getting around: **Taxi** TOP \$5–20 (city); TOP \$350 for 4–5 hr island tour · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Mapu 'a Vaea Blowholes** — Miles of lava coastline at Houma village where waves force plumes of water up to 30 metres into the air through natural...
- **Ha'amonga 'a Maui Trilithon** — Tonga's 'Stonehenge' — a massive three-slab stone archway erected in the 13th century as a royal gateway or...
- **Anahulu Cave Swim** — Descend into a limestone cavern of stalactites and stalagmites, then swim in the cool freshwater pool inside.
- **Pangaimotu Island Day Trip** — A 10–15 minute water taxi from Fuaa Jetty lands you on a classic South Pacific island with white sand, snorkeling...
- **Talamahu Market & Town Walk** — Wander Nuku'alofa's main market for taro, tropical fruit, woven mats, and wood carvings — then visit the Royal Palace...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Market Loop** 2.5 km · 30–40 min · Flat — A simple loop taking in all of walkable Nuku'alofa: head right from the pier along the waterfront to the Royal Palace fence, continue...

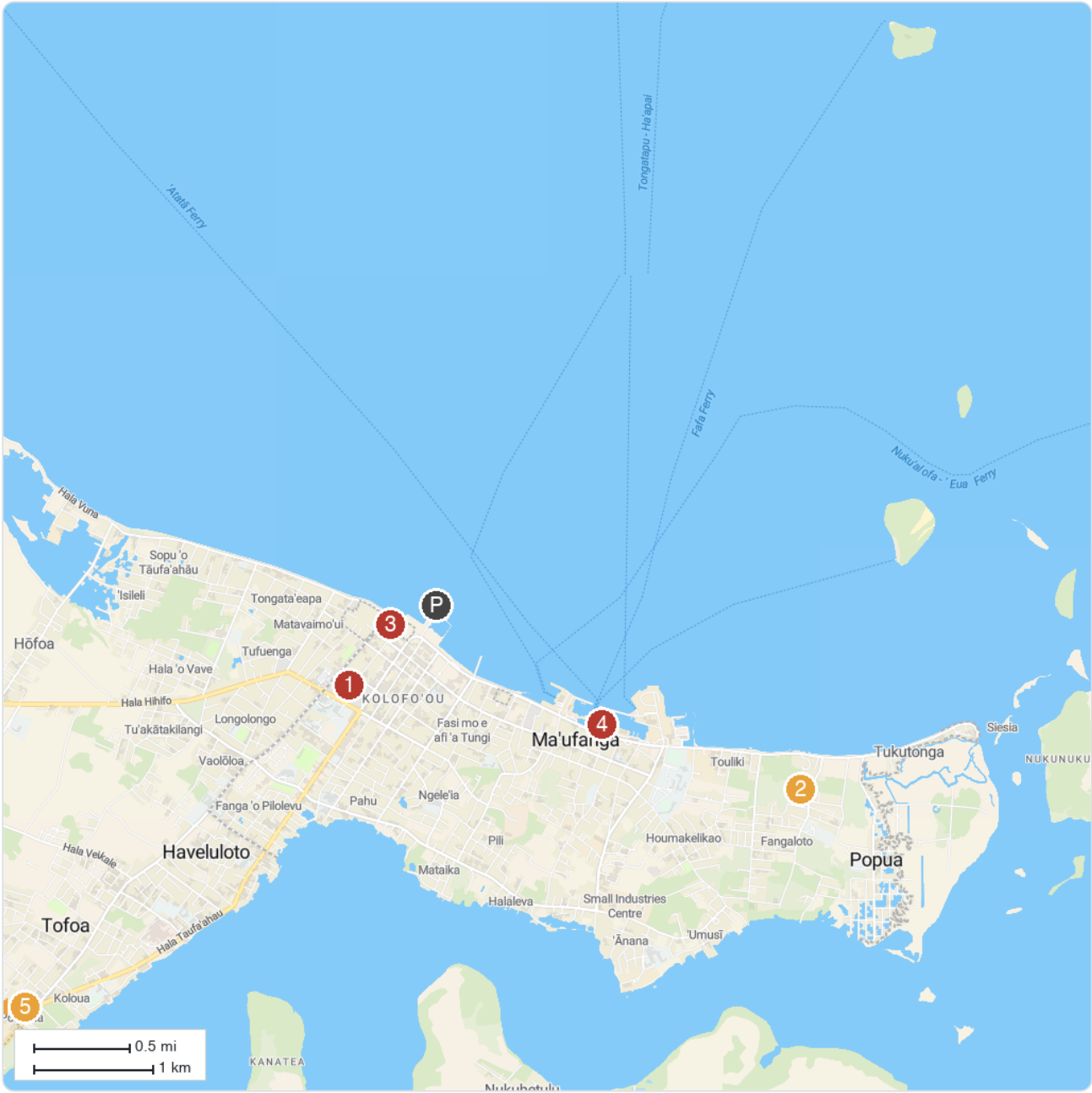
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Sunday shutdown is real. By constitutional law, Tonga closes completely on Sundays — shops, restaurants, taxis, markets, everything. If your ship is in port on a Sunday, pre-book...
- Dress modestly in town. Tongan culture is conservative — being shirtless in public is actually illegal. Cover shoulders and knees
