GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — West Wharf 1 or 2; shuttle required (no walk-out)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Omaezaki Lighthouse Climb** — Built in 1874 by British engineer Richard Henry Brunton, this working lighthouse is one of the few in Japan open for...
- **Seafood at Sea-side Marina Nabura** — The local fish market hub is a short shuttle hop from the pier.
- **Kakegawa Castle Day Trip** — About 45 minutes inland, Kakegawa Castle is one of Japan's authentically reconstructed wooden castles (rebuilt 1994...
- **Makinohara Green Tea Plantations** — Shizuoka produces roughly 40% of Japan's green tea, and the Makinohara plateau is its epicenter — rolling fields of...
- **Loggerhead Sea Turtle Nesting Beaches** — Omaezaki's beaches are a designated National Natural Monument for endangered loggerhead sea turtle nesting (May–August).

BEST WALKS

- **Cape Promenade to the Lighthouse** 1.5 km · Easy–Moderate · 30-40 min one way — From the Nabura Market shuttle stop, follow the coastal path southwest along the cape toward the lighthouse.
- **Nabura Market & Coastal Stroll** ~1 km · Easy · 20-30 min — A relaxed loop around the Nabura Market seafood area and the adjacent Marine Park.

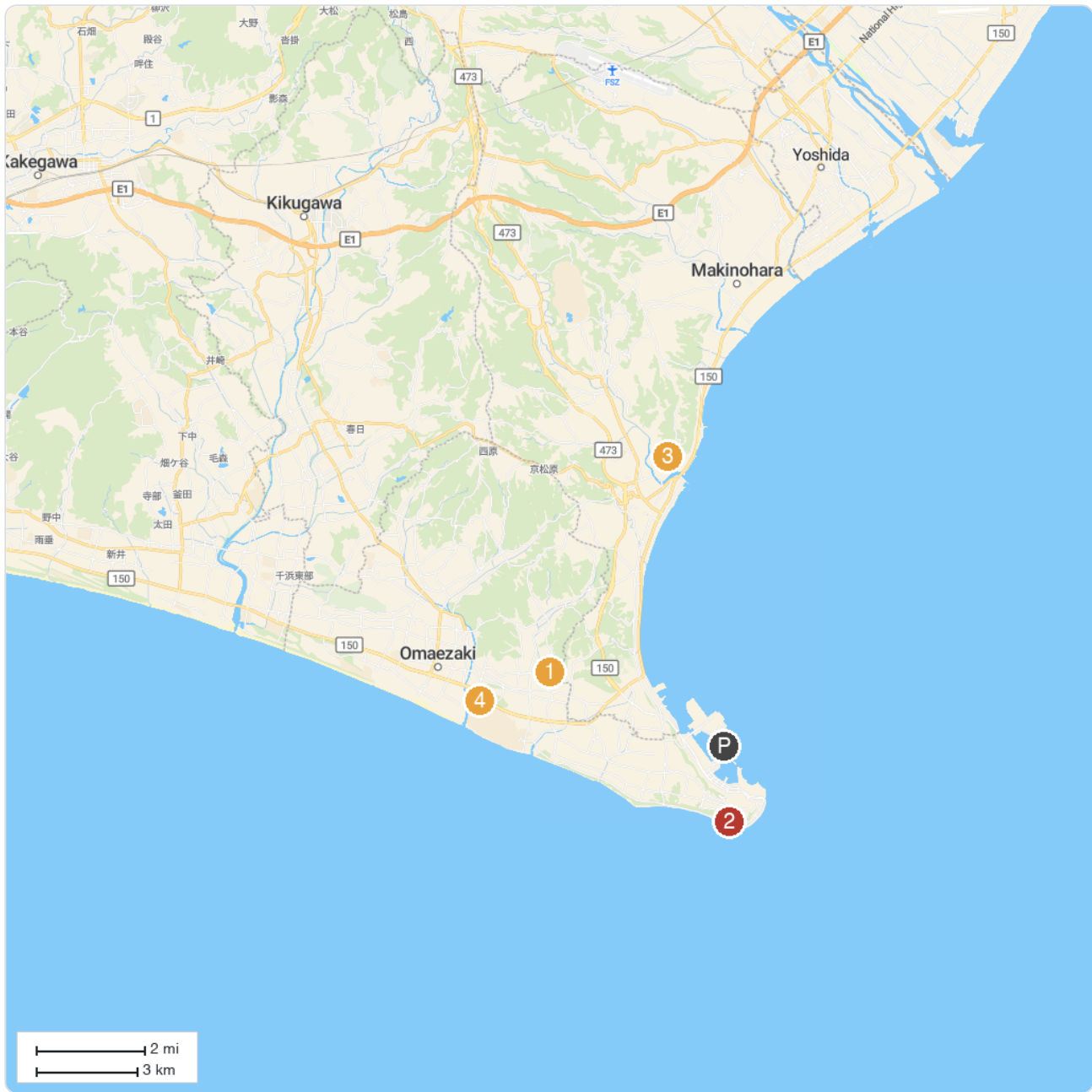
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring yen in cash. Smaller seafood stalls, the lighthouse entry, and most local shops are cash-only. Credit cards work at larger stores but don't count on them at the market.
- The shuttle is your lifeline. You cannot walk out of the industrial port gates. Confirm shuttle times with your ship before heading out

- 4 Hamaoka Nuclear Power Museum** Museum explaining nuclear power generation and energy science.
