Where the emerald Cetina River carves through towering karst cliffs to meet the Adriatic, Omiš packs centuries of pirate lore, cliffside fortresses, and rare sandy beaches into one compact, walkable port of call.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender for larger ships; small coastal cruisers dock at town quay

Walk to center: Steps off the tender — you land in the Old Town

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Cetina Canyon Zipline** — Eight steel cables stretch across the canyon 150 m above the river — one of the best ziplines in Europe.
 - **Cetina River Canyon Boat Ride** — Open wooden boats depart from the bridge and cruise upriver through the dramatic karst canyon to Radmanove Mlinice...
 - **Mirabella Fortress Climb** — A 13th-century Romanesque pirate lookout perched on the cliff directly above the Old
- Town.

 - **Starigrad Fortress Hike** — The high fortress at 311 m above sea level requires a serious 45–60 min uphill hike on a rocky mountain path.
 - **Velika Plaža — Sandy Beach Day** — Unusually for Croatia, Omiš has a genuine sandy beach — sediment brought down by the Cetina.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town & Mirabella Fortress Loop** 2–3 hrs · Moderate (steep climb to fortress) · ~2 km — Start on the Riva waterfront, explore the stone-paved alleys of the Old Town, then follow signs up the cliff staircase to Mirabella...
- **Riva to Velika Plaža (Sandy Beach)** 10–15 min walk each way · Easy · ~700 m — Head south from the tender pier along the coastal promenade past the mouth of the Cetina River to Velika Plaža — a wide sandy beach...

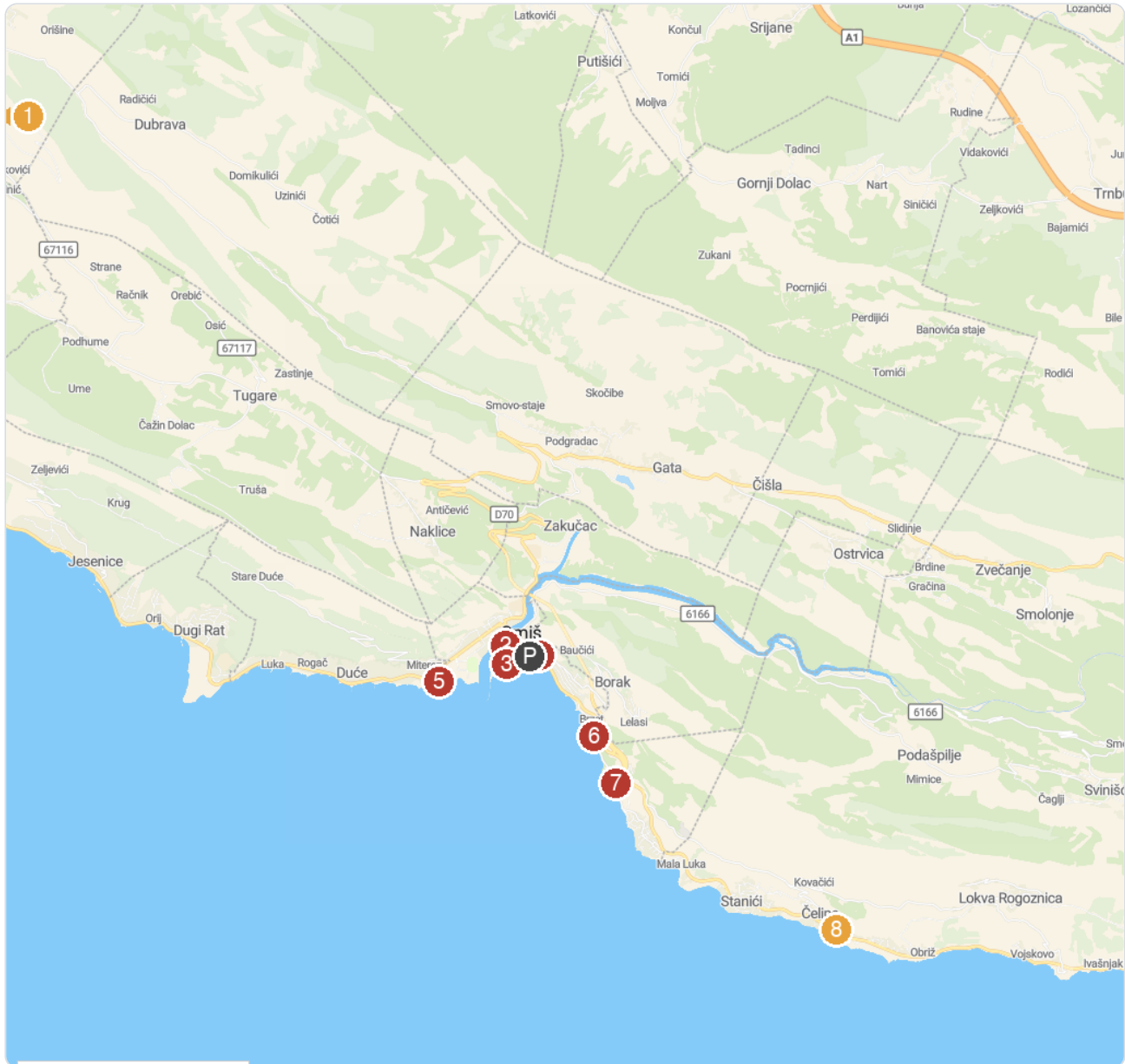
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
