TOP THINGS TO DO

- Oxford-Bellevue Ferry Crossing** — Hop aboard America's oldest continuously operating privately owned ferry, in service since 1683.
 - Oxford Museum & Historic Walk** — The Oxford Museum covers three centuries of maritime history with artifacts, photos, and colonial-era exhibits.
- Oxford–St. Michaels Bike Trail** — One of the best cycling routes on the Mid-Atlantic coast — a flat 12-mile round trip (or one-way to St.
 - Oxford Conservation Park** — An 86-acre wetland park on the edge of town with walking and biking trails, viewing platforms, and excellent birding...
 - Chesapeake Seafood & Ice Cream** — Oxford takes its food seriously.

- Town Center Stroll** 0.5 mi · 15 min · Easy — Walk from the Strand Road wharf along The Strand to Morris Street, past the Robert Morris Inn, Oxford Museum, and down to the...
- Oxford Park & Shoreline Walk** 1 mi · 25 min · Easy — Head to Oxford Park on the Tred Avon waterfront for river views, a living shoreline, and picnic benches — a quiet escape with a great...

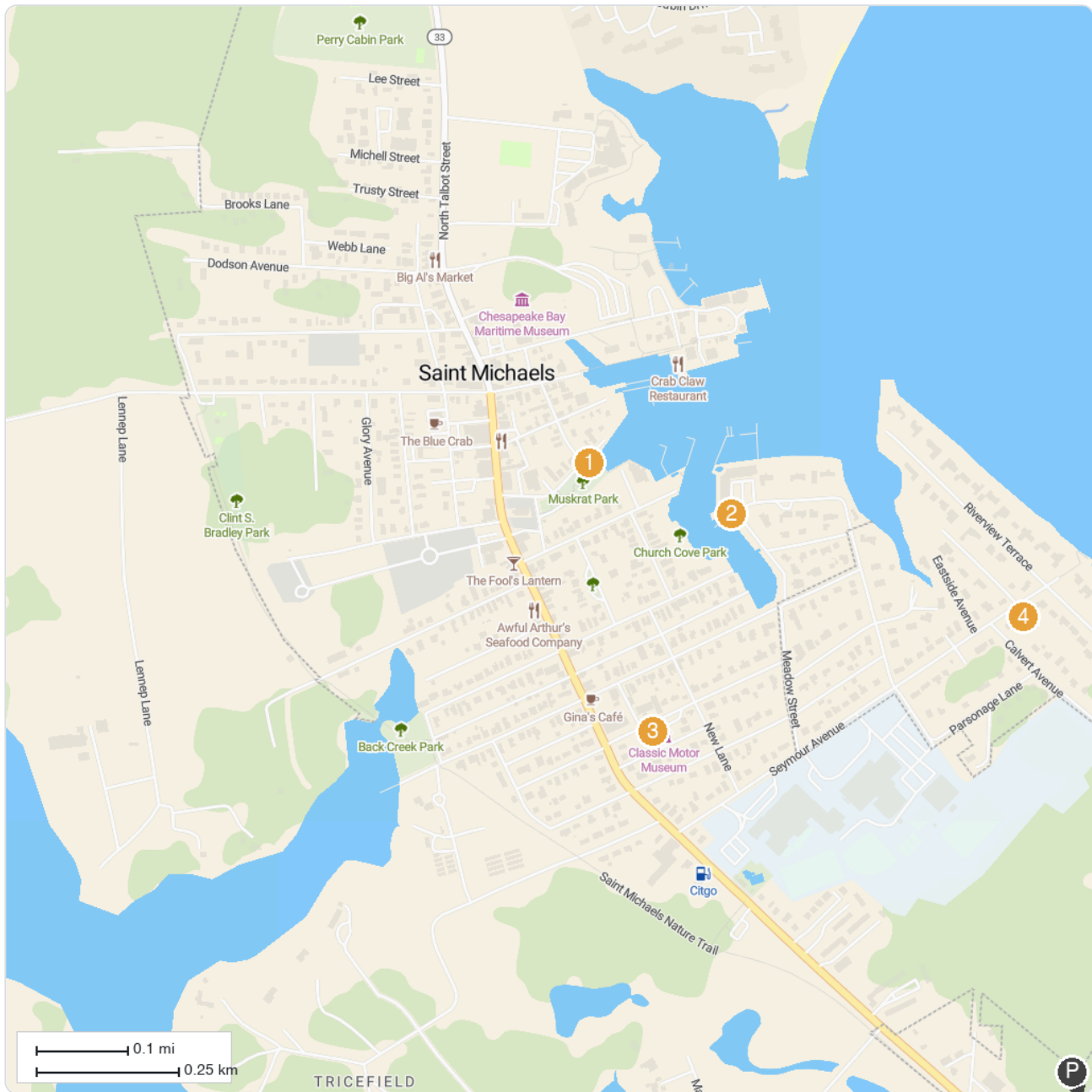
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
