GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in the bay; boats ferry you to the main jetty

Best For: Snorkeling, East Bali day trips, temples, and fresh seafood

Walk to town: Steps from tender jetty; Blue Lagoon Beach 10–15 min on foot

Don't Miss: Blue Lagoon snorkeling, Pura Silayukti temple, and Tirta Gangga Water Palace

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Blue Lagoon Snorkeling** — A 10-minute walk north over the hill reveals a sheltered white-sand cove with some of Bali's best accessible snorkeling...
- **Tirta Gangga Water Palace** — About 45 minutes by car, this former Karangasem royal palace is a maze of koi-filled pools, ornate stepping stones, and...
- **Tenganan Bali Aga Village** — One of Bali's last original pre-Hindu villages, Tenganan preserves ancient architecture and the rare double-ikat...
- **Klungkung Court of Justice** — The Kertha Gosa pavilion at the historic Klungkung palace complex features stunning ceiling paintings depicting...
- **Bias Tugel (White Sand) Beach** — A hidden cove 15–20 minutes on foot from the pier, protected by a rocky headland with softer sand and a calmer vibe...

BEST WALKS

- **Town & Pura Silayukti Temple Walk** 30–45 min | Easy | Free — From the tender jetty, stroll along the main beach road past colorful jukung fishing boats, then follow the path north to the headland...
- **Blue Lagoon Beach Hike** 10–15 min each way | Moderate (hill) | Free — Head north from the jetty and follow the path up and over the hill to Blue Lagoon Beach.

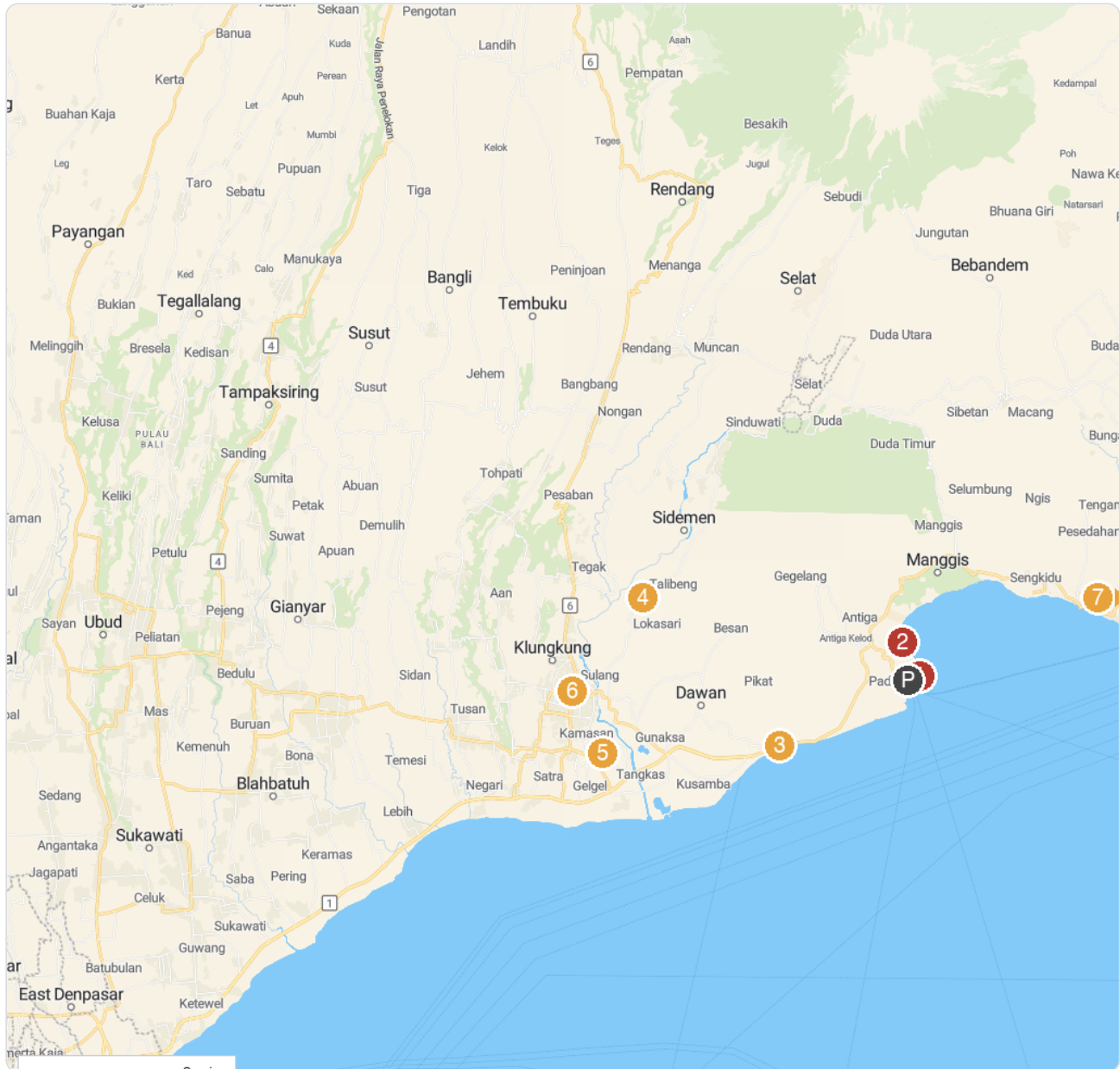
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
