GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Canal berth (barge/river cruise only; no large cruise ships)

Walk to center: 0 min — step off directly onto the quayside

Best For: Beaches, flamingo spotting, cycling to Montpellier

Don't Miss: Phare de la Méditerranée observation deck & the Transcanal chairlift

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  €8 minimum (within town); €35–€45 to Montpellier ·  **Rideshare**  Uber

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Phare de la Méditerranée** — Ride up the 43m observation tower (a converted 1940s water tower, roof at 45m) for 360° views of the sea, the saltwater...
- **Flamingo Spotting at the Étangs** — Walk or cycle the gravel paths bordering the coastal lagoons (Étang du Grec, Étang de l'Arnel, Méjean reserve) to spot...
- **Cathédrale de Maguelone** — An isolated 12th-century Romanesque cathedral on a former island (now a sandbar peninsula) 4km west, surrounded by...
- **Albert Dubout Museum** — Inside the 18th-century Redoute de Ballestras in Parc du Levant, this museum celebrates the French cartoonist who...
- **Blue Flag Beaches** — Seven kilometers of fine sandy beaches line both banks of the canal.

BEST WALKS

- **Canal & Town Walk** 1.5km · 30-45 min · flat — Cross between Rive Gauche and Rive Droite using the swing bridges, watching them rotate to let yachts pass.
- **Lagoon & Flamingo Loop (Cycling)** 8-12km · 1.5-2.5 hrs · flat cycling — Rent a bike and take the lagoon-side path northwest toward the Méjean regional nature reserve, scanning the étangs for pink flamingos.

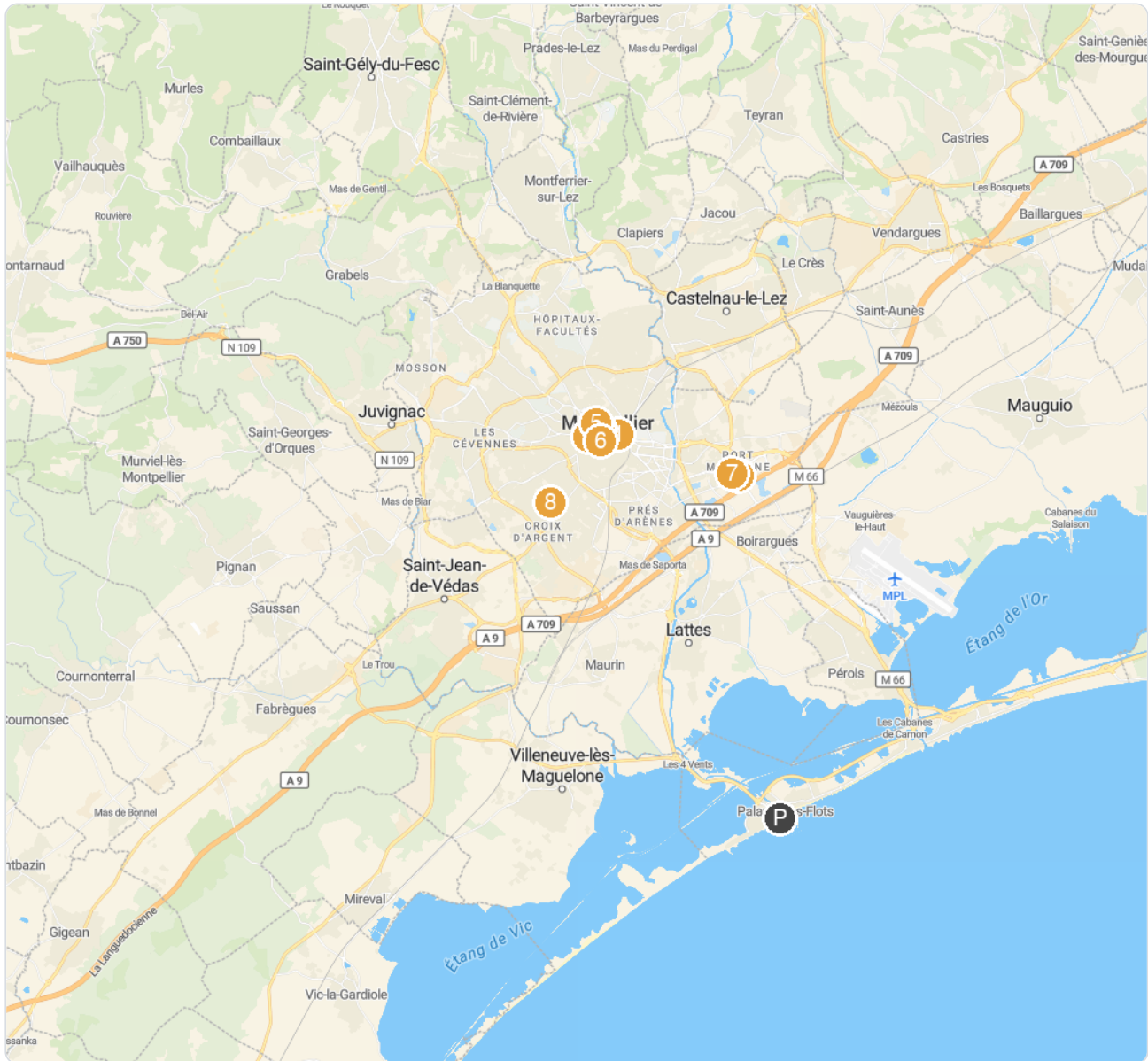
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Small-vessel port only. Large ocean cruise ships cannot enter Palavas — if your ship docks at Sète, it's a 30-min taxi or train + tram to Palavas.
- Rent a bike. The flat lagoon paths are ideal for cycling to the Cathédrale de Maguelone (4km) or all the way into Montpellier.
