Docking: Ships berth at Nassau Cruise Port — water taxi or taxi to Paradise Island (~10 min)

Best For: Atlantis Aquaventure, Cabbage Beach, Royal Beach Club (Royal Caribbean)

Walk to center: Not walkable from ship; ~2 miles with a steep bridge — take a taxi

Don't Miss: Marina Village is free to explore — walk the docks and grab conch salad at Potter's Cay

Getting around:  Taxi  \$7/person one-way, \$14 round-trip ·  Rideshare  not available

- Atlantis Aquaventure Waterpark** — 141 acres of water slides, a mile-long lazy river with rapids, 11 pools, and the legendary Leap of Faith plunge through...
- Royal Beach Club (Royal Caribbean)** — Royal Caribbean's exclusive 17-acre beach club opened December 2025, featuring two beaches, three pool zones, the...
- The Dig — Atlantis Marine Habitat** — Walk through glass tunnels as sharks, manta rays, and 50,000 marine animals surround you in the world's largest...
- Cabbage Beach Day** — Paradise Island's best public beach: powdery white sand, turquoise water, and chair rentals from local vendors.
- Marina Village & Atlantis Casino** — Stroll the colorful open-air Marina Village — shops, mega-yachts, dining, and live music — all free to enter.

BEST WALKS

- Marina Village to Cabbage Beach** ~1.2 miles • 25 min • Easy — From the water taxi dock, walk through Marina Village past the mega-yachts and boutiques, continue through the Atlantis grounds (free...
- Nassau Waterfront Stroll (ship to bridge)** ~0.8 miles one-way • 15 min • Easy — A flat, shaded walk from Prince George Wharf east along Bay Street and Woodes Rogers Walk to the Paradise Island bridge causeway.
