GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor offshore; boats drop at Parikia ferry pier

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Parikia Old Town & Church of 100 Doors** — Walk the marble-paved lanes of Parikia's old town to the Panagia Ekatontapyliani, one of Greece's most important early...
- Kolymbithres Beach & Naoussa** — Ride the bus or taxi to Naoussa (15-20 min), then continue to Kolymbithres for its famous moon-like granite rock...
- Ancient Marble Quarries of Marathi** — Visit the inland quarries where ancient sculptors sourced the legendary translucent Parian marble used for the Venus de...
- Day Trip to Antiparos Island** — Take a ferry from Pounta port (taxi transfer from Parikia) for the 7-minute crossing to Antiparos.
- Livadia or Krios Beach** — Livadia is a 15-minute walk from the tender pier — sandy, family-friendly, with sunbed rentals and tavernas.

BEST WALKS

- Parikia Old Town & Kastro Loop** 1.5 km · ~45 min · Easy — From the ferry pier, walk past the windmill into the old town, head up through narrow marble-paved lanes to the Frankish Kastro, then...
- Pier to Livadia Beach** 1.2 km one way · ~15 min · Flat — A simple flat walk north from the tender pier along the coast to Livadia Beach, passing small cafes and a playground.

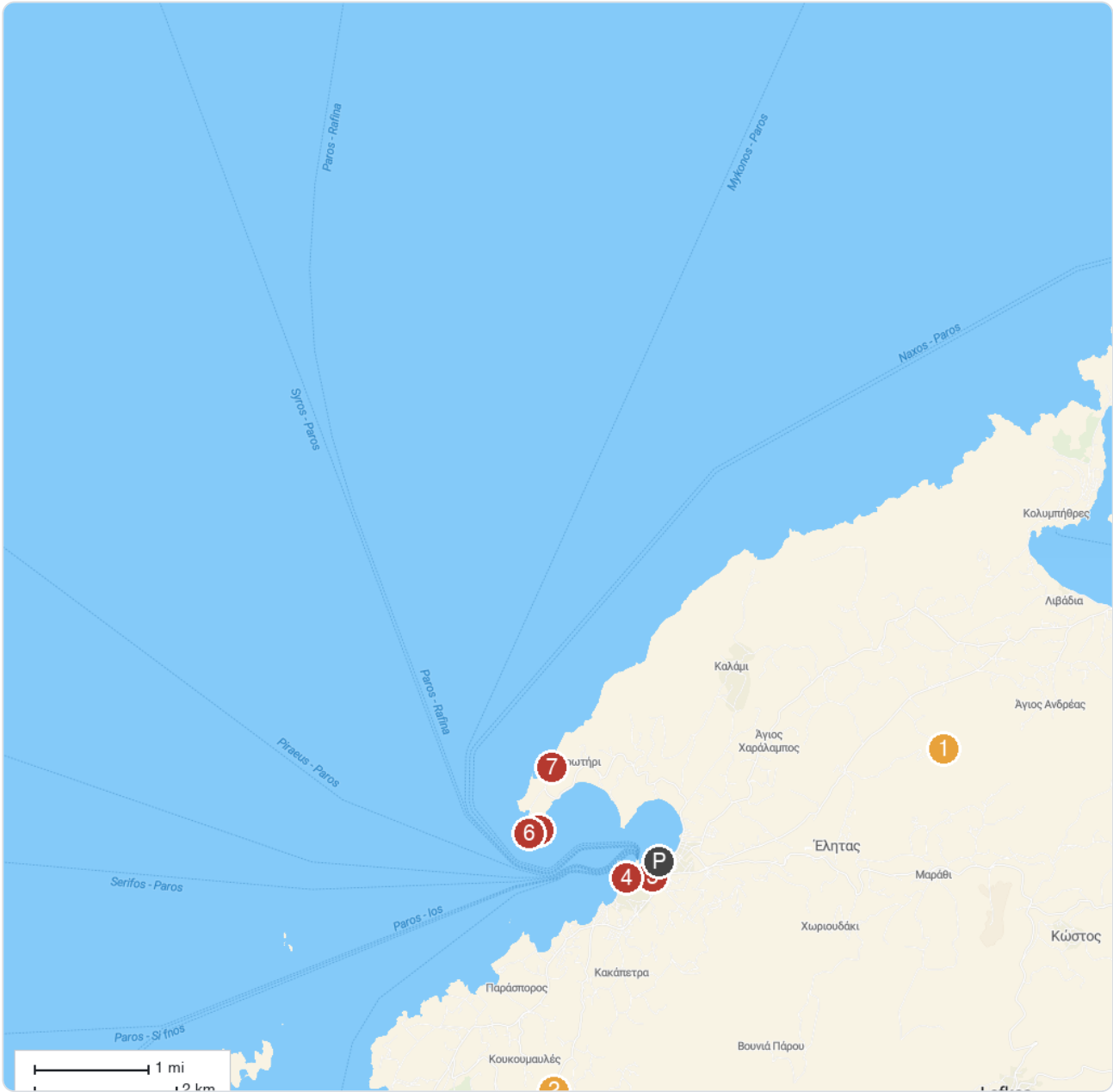
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
