TOP THINGS TO DO

- Island Queen 30,000 Islands Cruise** — Board the Island Queen catamaran for a 2- or 3-hour narrated cruise through the world's largest freshwater archipelago.
- Georgian Bay Airways Floatplane Tour** — Lift off from the Town Dock seaplane base for an aerial view of the 30,000 Islands that no boat can match.
- Bobby Orr Hall of Fame** — Parry Sound's most famous son is celebrated in this interactive sports heritage museum
- Tower Hill Lookout & Museum on Tower Hill** — Climb 130 steps up a 98-foot (30 m) observation tower for 360-degree views of the harbour, the CPR Trestle, and...
- Rotary Waterfront Trail & Waubuno Beach** — A 3.3 km crushed-granite trail follows the Georgian Bay shoreline, passing through parkland to Waubuno Beach — a sandy... inside the Stockey Centre, steps...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront to Downtown Loop** 3-4 km · 45-60 min · Mostly flat with one uphill stretch — From the Town Dock, follow the waterfront park past the Stockey Centre, then head up Bay Street to downtown James Street for shops...
- Waterfront Trail to Tower Hill** 4-5 km round trip · 60-80 min · One steep climb — Head north along the flat Rotary Waterfront Trail, then cut inland up to Tower Hill for the observation tower and sweeping views over...
