**Don't Miss:** LaPointe-Krebs House (1757) — oldest standing structure in Mississippi

## TOP THINGS TO DO

- **LaPointe-Krebs House & Museum** — Built around 1757 (confirmed by dendrochronology), this French Colonial structure is the oldest standing structure in...
- **Pascagoula River Audubon Center** — Gateway to the largest free-flowing (undammed, unlevied) river system in the lower 48 states.
- **Gulf Coast Gator Ranch Airboat Tour** — Just north of Pascagoula in Moss Point, this ranch sends you screaming across gator-filled swamplands on a high-speed...
- **Downtown Scranton Walking Tour** — Pascagoula's historic Scranton district is a designated Main Street community with over 30 National Register buildings...
- **Round Island Lighthouse** — Originally built offshore on Round Island, this 1859 lighthouse was battered by hurricanes and finally reassembled in...

## BEST WALKS

- **Riverfront to Scranton Historic District** ~1 mile • Easy • 20-30 min one way — From the Riverfront Park dock, walk into the Scranton district past Victorian homes, the River Art Gallery, Anchor Square, and the...
- **Lighthouse Park & Beach Walk** ~2.5 miles from downtown • Easy • Best by taxi/Uber — Head south to Lighthouse Park (home of the UFO abduction marker), then continue along the waterfront to Pascagoula Beach Park with its...

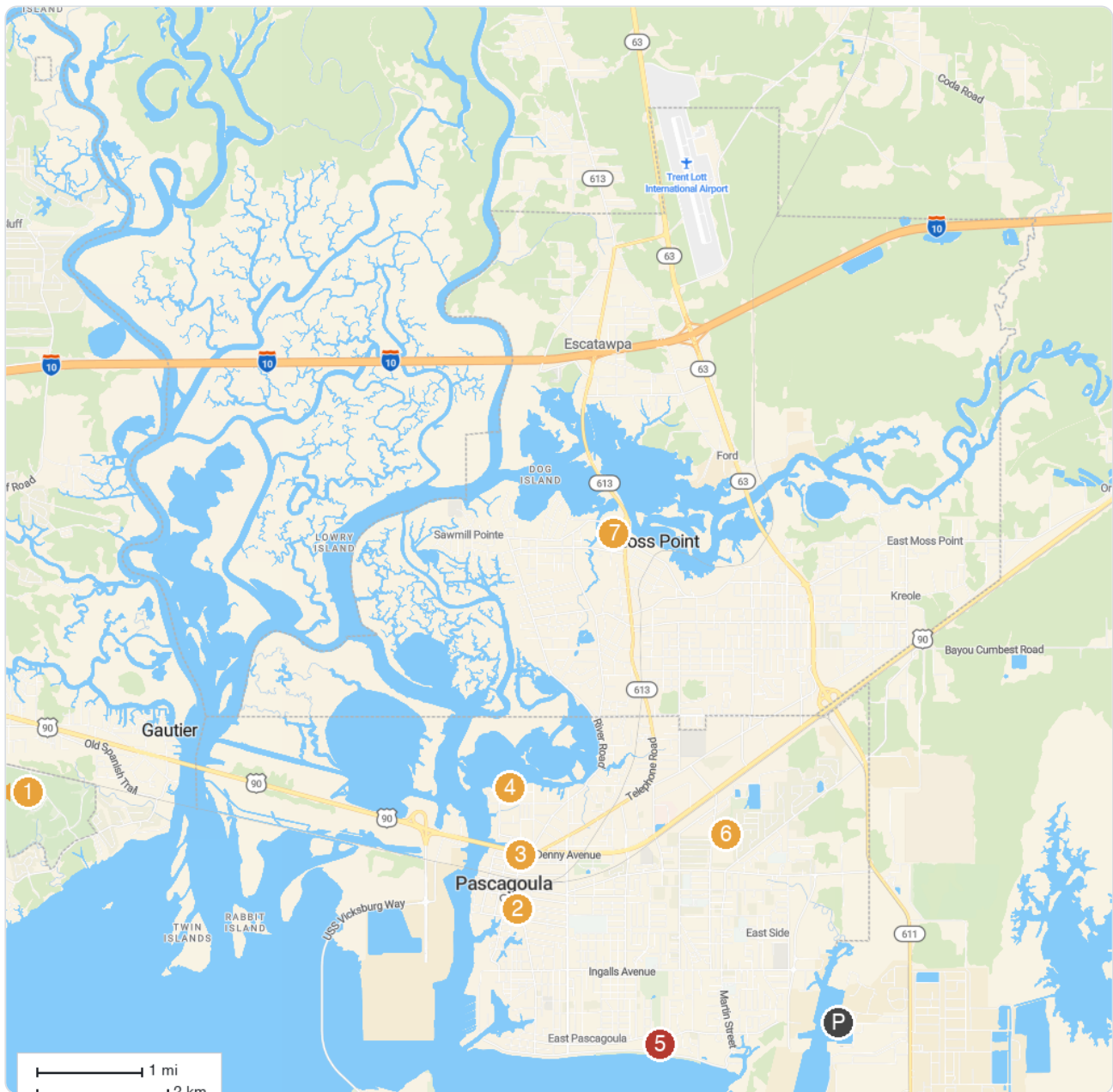
## KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- 1** **Shepard State Park** A state park for camping, fishing, boating, and nature trails.
- 3** **Round Island Lighthouse** Explore a historic, restored lighthouse, now on the mainland.
- 5** **Pascagoula Beach Park** A public beach park with sand, playground, and picnic areas.
- 7** **Pascagoula River Audubon Center** Discover local wildlife, birds, and the Pascagoula River ecosystem.

- 2** **Pascagoula Parks & Recreation** Enjoy public parks, playgrounds, and recreational facilities city-wide.
- 4** **La Pointe - Krebs Museum** Visit Mississippi's oldest building, a historic house museum.
- 6** **Keith's Park** A local community park with playgrounds and green space.
