GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Skala port for most cruise ships; small vessels may dock at Skala pier

Best For: History, pilgrimage, medieval architecture, low-key Aegean beaches

Walk to center: Tender drops you in the center of Skala — shops and cafés immediate

Don't Miss: Cave of the Apocalypse + Monastery of St. John — go early before afternoon closure

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Cave of the Apocalypse & Monastery of St. John** — Visit the sacred grotto where Saint John received his visions (~€4 entry), then continue uphill to the 11th-century...
- **Chora Medieval Village Walk** — The hilltop capital is a labyrinth of whitewashed alleys, high stone walls, and hidden squares built to repel pirate...
- **Kampos Beach Day** — The island's most popular organized beach, 5.5 km from Skala, with shallow calm water, sunbeds, water sports, and a...
- **ATV Island Loop** — Rent an ATV from the waterfront and explore Patmos on your own terms — Chora, the windmills, Petra Beach with its...
- **Island-Hopping Boat Trip** — Local operators offer day trips from Skala to nearby uninhabited islets — Arki and Marathi — with pristine beaches and...

BEST WALKS

- **Skala Waterfront Stroll** 1 km · Easy · 15 min — A flat waterfront loop through Skala — cafés, shops, the small church of Agia Paraskevi, and views of anchored cruise ships in the bay.
- **Byzantine Path: Chora to Skala** 3.5 km · Moderate downhill · 45–60 min — Take a taxi or bus up to Chora, then walk the ancient cobblestone path downhill.
- **Walk to Meloi Beach** 1.5 km · Easy · 20 min — Head north from the port along a flat coastal path to Meloi Beach — a quiet, narrow strip shaded by tamarisk trees with a taverna.
