TOP THINGS TO DO

- Bonaventure Island Gannet Colony** — A narrated boat cruise circles Percé Rock, then drops you on Bonaventure Island.
 - Percé UNESCO Global Geopark** — Explore 500 million years of geology via the Tektonik multimedia pavilion, hiking trails, and a suspended glass...
- Promenade de la Grave Heritage Walk** — Follow this historic shoreside circuit past restored 19th-century buildings of the Charles Robin Company — the...
 - Gaspé Lobster & Craft Beer Lunch** — Percé is famous for Gaspé lobster (Homard de la Gaspésie), prized for its sweetness in cold, clean Gulf waters.
 - Sea Kayaking Around Percé Rock** — Paddle close to the iconic arch of Percé Rock under your own power.

BEST WALKS

- Village Waterfront & Boardwalk** 1-2 hrs • Easy • Flat — Stroll the La Promenade boardwalk from the wharf for unobstructed views of Percé Rock and Bonaventure Island, then continue to the...
- Mont-Joli Lookout** 45 min round-trip • Easy-moderate • Uphill — A short climb (about 10-15 min from the wharf) to this historic lookout delivers the classic panoramic shot of Percé Rock with the...
