GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender for most cruise ships; small vessels (under ~80m) may dock at Porto di Pesaro

Best For: Music lovers, beach days, art, Italian culture without the cruise crowds

Walk to Center: 15–20 min (1.2 km) via flat Viale della Repubblica from the harbor

Don't Miss: Casa Rossini museum, Sfera Grande sculpture on the seafront, Piazza del Popolo

 Getting around:  Taxi  €8–€12

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Casa Rossini & Teatro Rossini** — Visit the birthplace of Gioachino Rossini, now an interactive museum of his life, operas, and famous culinary obsessions.
- **Musei Civici — Bellini & Renaissance Ceramics** — Palazzo Mosca houses Giovanni Bellini's masterpiece 'Coronation of the Virgin' and a superb collection of Renaissance...
- **Roman Domus in Via dell'Abbondanza** — Step into a 1st-century AD Roman home preserved beneath the city, complete with floor mosaics and 3D virtual...
- **Monte San Bartolo Nature Reserve** — Just north of the port, this coastal nature reserve offers panoramic clifftop walks above the Adriatic with views of...
- **Day Trip to Urbino** — With a long port call (8+ hrs), taxi or join a shore excursion to Urbino — a UNESCO World Heritage Renaissance hill...

BEST WALKS

- **Port to Piazza del Popolo** 1.2 km · 15–20 min · flat — Walk straight up Viale della Repubblica from the harbor basin to Pesaro's grand Renaissance heart.
- **Seafront Promenade & Pomodoro Sphere** 1.5 km one way · 20 min · flat seafront — Head east from the port along the seafront boulevard to find Arnaldo Pomodoro's giant bronze Sfera Grande — Pesaro's modern icon...

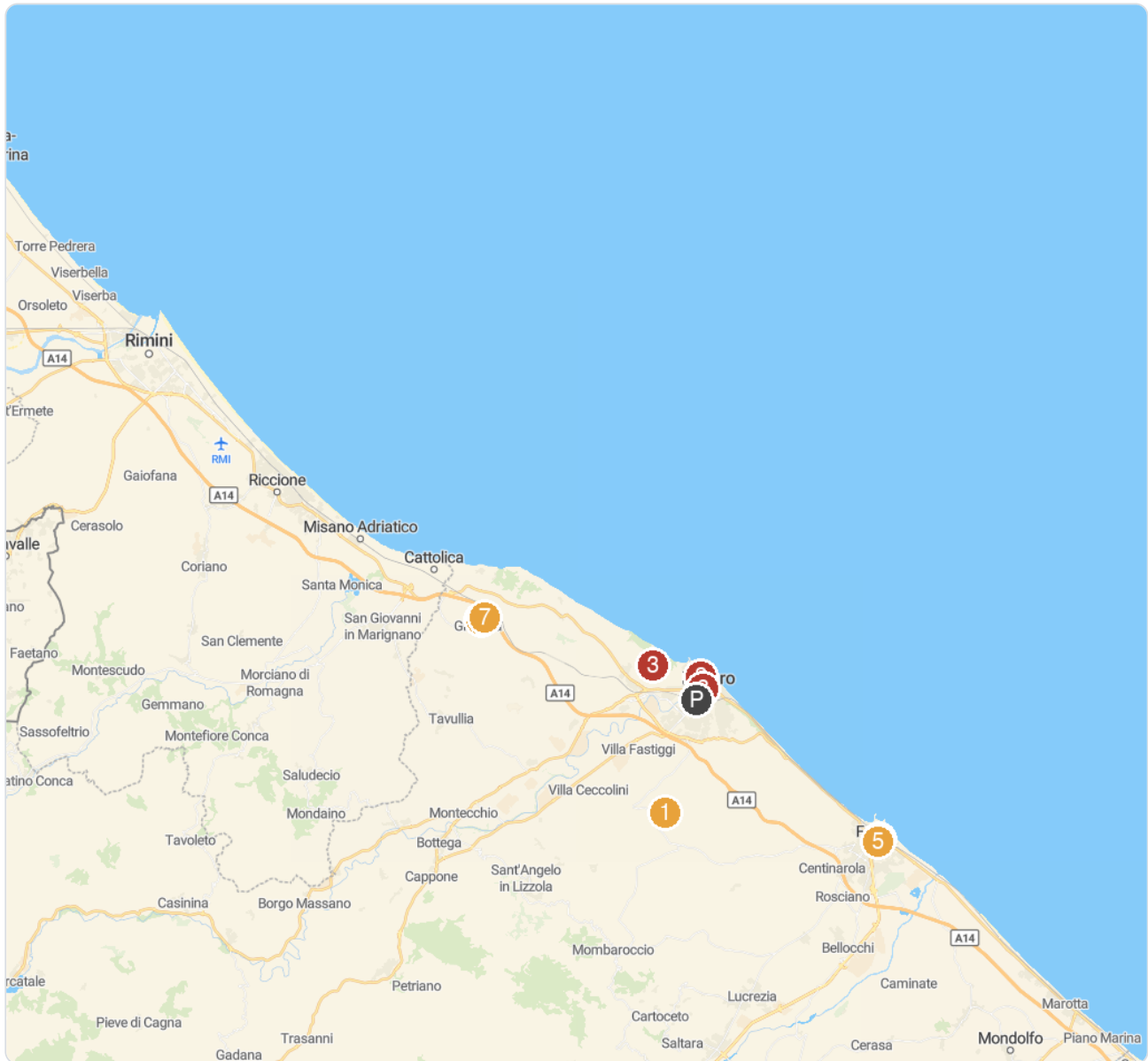
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
