TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Tuol Sleng (S-21) & Killing Fields** — The former Khmer Rouge prison S-21 and the Choeung Ek memorial are essential, sobering visits that contextualise modern...
- **Royal Palace & Silver Pagoda** — The King's official residence features gleaming Khmer rooflines and the Silver Pagoda, whose floor is laid with over...
- **National Museum of Cambodia** — A beautiful terracotta pavilion next to the Royal Palace housing the world's finest collection of Khmer sculpture and...
- **Khmer Street Food & Central Market** — Phnom Penh's 1937 Art Deco Central Market (Psar Thmei) is worth a visit for the architecture alone.
- **Sisowath Quay Sunset & Rooftop Bars** — The Riverside promenade comes alive at dusk.

BEST WALKS

- **Riverside Promenade to Royal Palace** 2 km · 25 min · Easy · Flat — Head south along Sisowath Quay from the pier, passing riverside cafés and the Colonial-era FCC building, to reach the Royal Palace...
- **Pier to Wat Phnom** 1 km · 10 min · Easy · Flat — Walk north along the quay to the small wooded hill of Wat Phnom — the founding temple of the city.

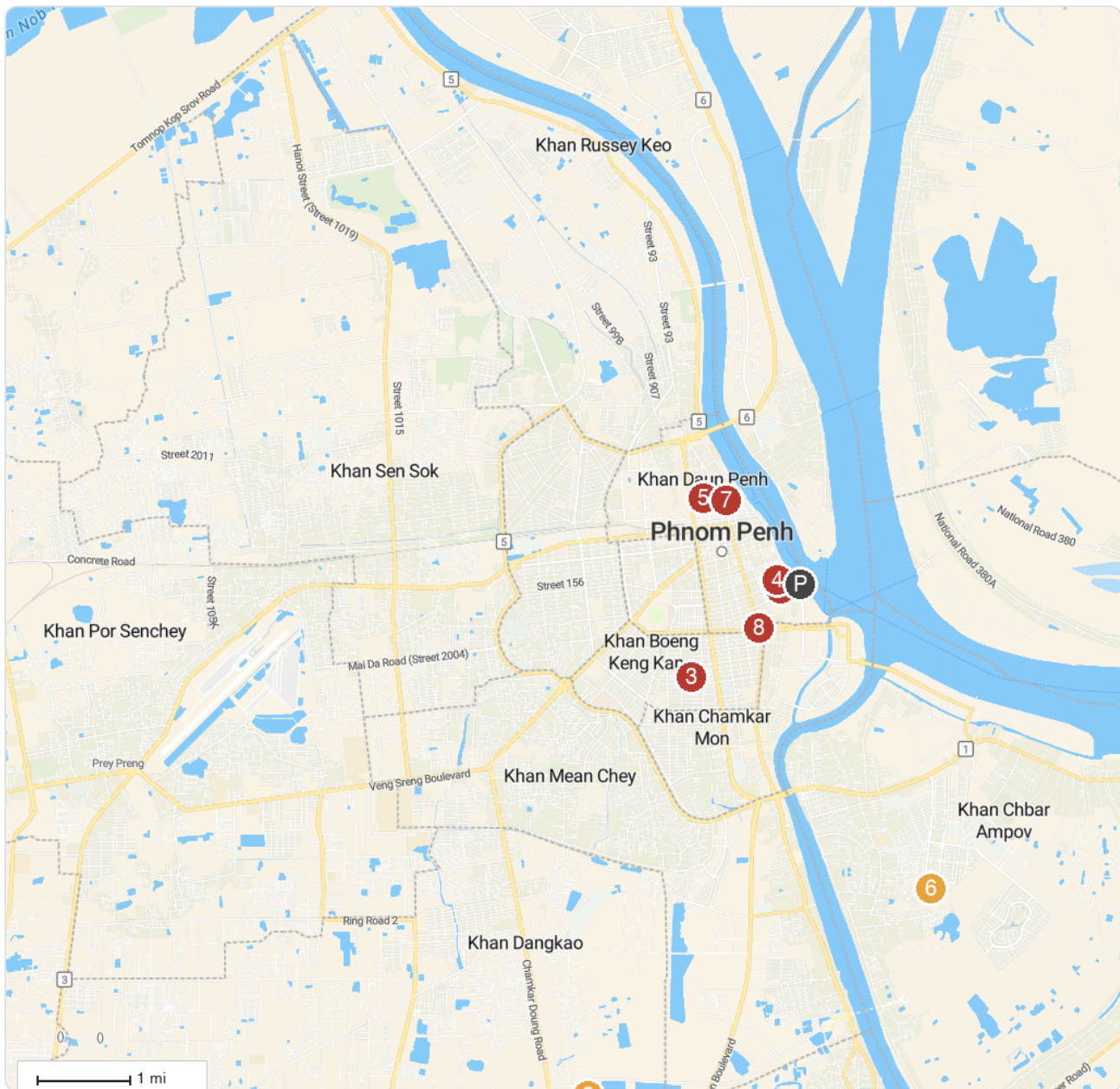
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pristine dollars only. USD is the de-facto currency. Any torn, creased, or marked bill will be refused by merchants and street vendors — bring crisp notes from the ship.
- Use Grab or PassApp. These ride-hailing apps give a fixed fare and eliminate tuk-tuk haggling. Download before arrival — they

- 3** **Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum** Former S-21 prison, now a genocide museum.
- 5** **National Library** Cambodia's main national library.
- 7** **Wat Phnom Daun Penh** Historic Buddhist temple on a hill, city's namesake.
- P** **Cruise port / terminal**

- 2** **Choeung Ek Genocidal Center** Former Khmer Rouge killing field and memorial site.
- 4** **Royal Palace of Cambodia** Official residence of the King of Cambodia.
- 6** **PH Euro Park** A European-themed amusement park.
- 8** **Independence Monument** Monument commemorating Cambodia's independence from France.
