Docking: North Shore Riverfront (Allegheny R.) or Station Square (Monongahela R.)

Best For: History, arts, food, iconic skyline views from Mt. Washington

Walk to Center: ~20 min to Point State Park via pedestrian bridge; free T light rail cuts it to 5 min

Don't Miss: Duquesne Incline ride + Mt. Washington overlook, Primanti Bros. sandwich

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Duquesne Incline & Mt. Washington Overlook** — Board this 1877 wooden cable car for the ride up the side of Mt.
 - **The Andy Warhol Museum** — Seven floors dedicated to Pittsburgh's most famous son — the largest single-artist museum in North America.
 - **Senator John Heinz History Center** — Smithsonian-affiliated mega-museum tracing Pittsburgh's arc from the
- French & Indian War through the steel boom to the...

 - **Point State Park & the Three Rivers Fountain** — Walk the tip of the 'Golden Triangle' where the Allegheny and Monongahela merge to form the Ohio River.
 - **Strip District Food Walk** — Pittsburgh's historic market district, lined with Italian delis, Polish pierogies, coffee roasters, and street food...

BEST WALKS

- **North Shore Riverfront to Point State Park** ~1.5 miles | Easy | 30–40 min — Follow the Three Rivers Heritage Trail east along the Allegheny, cross the Fort Duquesne Bridge pedestrian walkway, and arrive at...
- **Andy Warhol Museum to Randyland Loop** ~1.2 miles | Moderate | 25 min — From the Andy Warhol Museum on Sandusky Street, walk north through the Allegheny neighborhood to Randyland — artist Randy Gilson's...

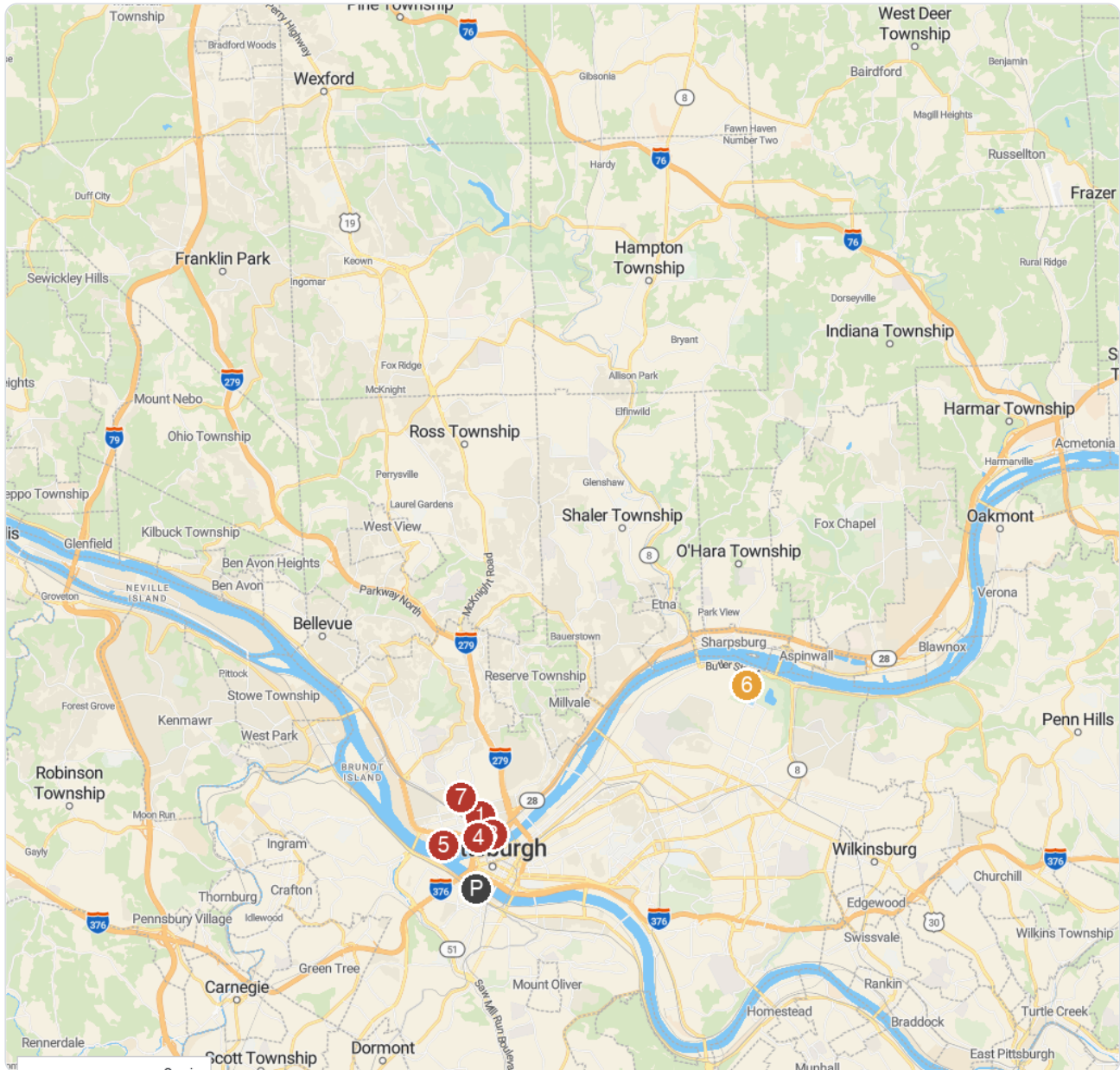
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
