GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Most ships dock in Cozumel; passengers take a 45-min ferry to PDC. Some ships dock at Calica pier 8 mi south.

Best For: Beach clubs, cenote swimming, Tulum day trips, street food, shopping

Walk to center: Ferry pier drops you at Parque Fundadores — Quinta Avenida is 2 min on foot. Calica requires taxi (~\$15 USD).

Don't Miss: Voladores de Papantla ritual at Parque Fundadores and tacos al pastor at El Fogón

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Cenote Swimming (Azul, Cristalino & Eden)** — Three stunning freshwater sinkholes clustered 20 minutes south of PDC via Colectivo or taxi.
- **Tulum Ruins Day Trip** — Perched on a cliff overlooking the turquoise Caribbean, Tulum is the most dramatically sited Mayan ruin in Mexico.
- **Xcaret or Xplor Eco-Park** — Xcaret blends Mayan cultural shows, wildlife, and underground river snorkeling.
- **Rio Secreto Underground Cave** — A semi-submerged cave system of stalactites and stalagmites just 15 minutes from PDC.
- **Mamitas or Lido Beach Club** — Pay a cover (usually redeemable against food/drinks) and claim a lounge on the Caribbean.

BEST WALKS

- **Parque Fundadores to Mamitas Beach** 1.5 miles • ~30 min • Easy — Start at the Portal Maya sculpture in Parque Fundadores, turn right onto Quinta Avenida, and walk north past cafés, boutiques, street...
- **Ferry Pier to Playacar Beach** 0.3 miles • ~5 min • Easy — Walk south from the ferry pier along the beach path past Señor Frog's into the Playacar residential zone.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Ferry timing is everything. If your ship is based in Cozumel, build in a 2-hour buffer before all-aboard — ferries run hourly and lines get long. Missing the last ferry means...
Buy one-way ferry tickets. Round-trip lock you into one company. With a one-way ticket you can board whichever Ultramar or

- 3 Xplor Park** Adventure park: zip lines, amphibious vehicles, and underground rivers.

- 7 3D Museum of Wonders** Interactive museum featuring optical illusions and 3D art.
- P Cruise port / terminal**

- 2 Río Secreto** Explore an underground river with ancient stalactites and stalagmites.
- 4 Gran Coyote Golf** Championship 18-hole golf course designed by Nick Price.
- 6 Grand Riviera Casino** Casino offering slot machines, table games, and entertainment.
- 8 Museo Frida Kahlo Playa Del Carmen** Museum dedicated to artist Frida Kahlo's life and work.
