GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Deepwater berth at Port of Port Angeles — ships dock directly, no tender

Best For: Olympic National Park, Hurricane Ridge, whale watching, Twilight fans

Walk to center: 5–10 min walk to downtown along the waterfront

Don't Miss: Hurricane Ridge views or a whale-watch on the Strait of Juan de Fuca

Getting around: **Taxi** \$5–\$15 · **Rideshare** Uber, Lyft

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Hurricane Ridge** — Shuttle or drive 17 miles up to 5,242 ft for panoramic views of the Olympic Mountains, glacier-carved valleys, and on...
 - Whale Watching on the Strait** — Puget Sound Express and other operators run mid-day tours from the Port Angeles Wharf into the Strait of Juan de Fuca...
- Hoh Rain Forest** — One of the largest temperate rainforests in North America, draped in moss-covered maples and Sitka spruce.
 - Lake Crescent Hike & Paddle** — Glacially carved and impossibly blue, Lake Crescent is 20 miles west of port.
 - Ferry to Victoria, BC** — The Black Ball Ferry (MV Coho) runs a 90-minute crossing to Victoria, British Columbia — one of Canada's most charming...

BEST WALKS

- City Pier to Downtown Front Street** 0.5 mi · Flat · 15 min — Stroll the waterfront from the City Pier past the Feiro Marine Life Center, along the promenade, and into downtown.
- Waterfront Trail toward Ediz Hook** 1-2 mi one-way · Flat · 30-60 min — Head west along the waterfront toward Ediz Hook, a natural sandy spit extending into the harbor.

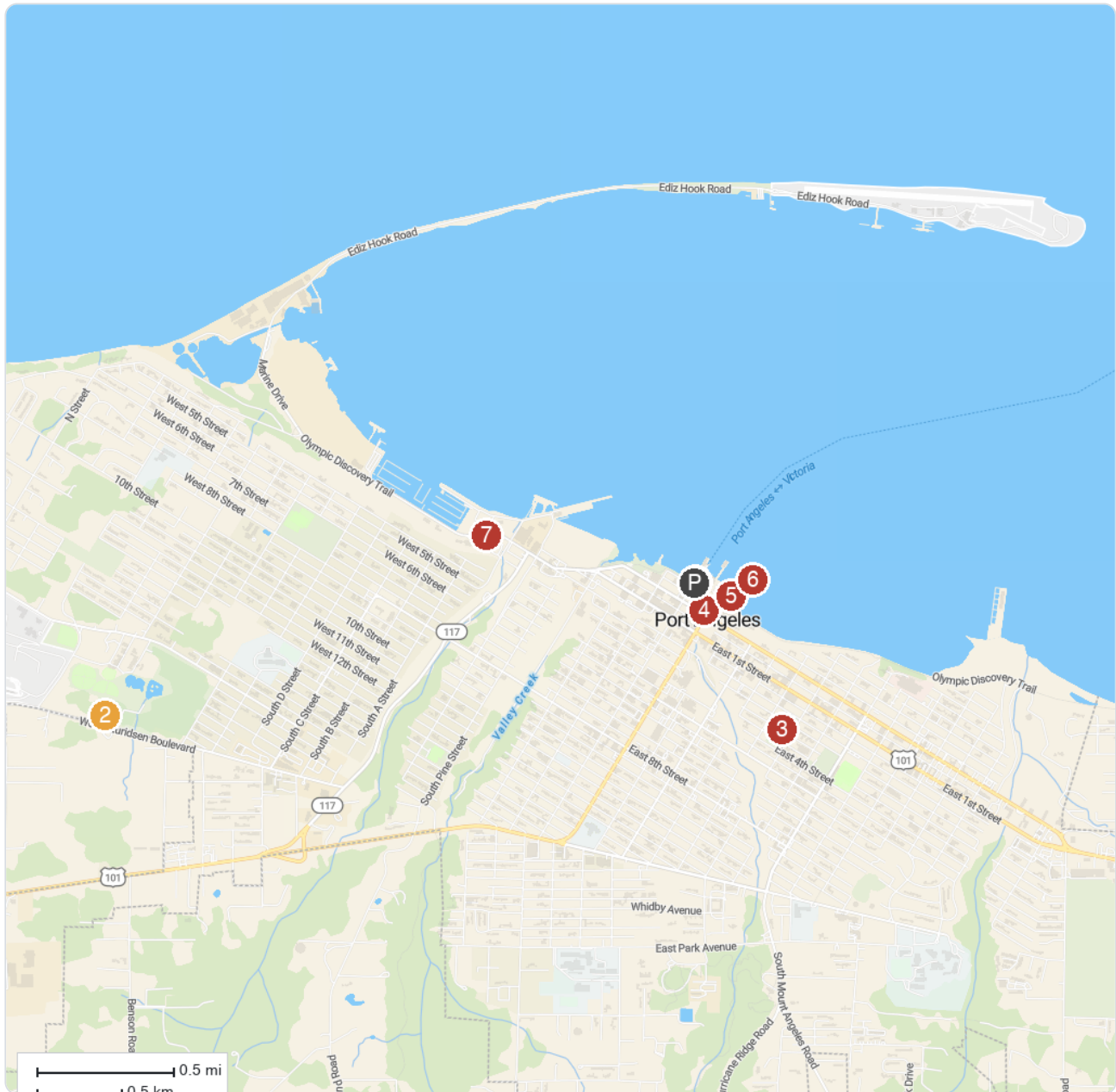
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Layer up: Even in summer, Hurricane Ridge runs 15–20°F colder than town. Bring a windproof jacket and sturdy walking shoes even if the pier looks sunny.
- Book Olympic excursions early: Hurricane Ridge has vehicle limits and tours sell out. Secure your spot weeks before your arrival.
