Docking: Docked at Haddo Wharf (Jetty No. 4); shuttle to gate required

Don't Miss: Cellular Jail light & sound show (evening) and Ross Island ruins

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Cellular Jail (Kala Pani)** — The most significant monument in the Andamans — a seven-wing star-shaped British colonial prison used to exile Indian...
- **Ross Island (Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Dweep) Ruins** — The former British administrative HQ — officially renamed Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Dweep in 2018 — is now a ghost...
- **Corbyn's Cove Beach** — The closest beach to Port Blair — a crescent of sand fringed with coconut palms.
- **Samudrika Marine Museum** — Run by the Indian Navy, this excellent museum covers the islands' marine life, indigenous tribes, and coral ecosystems.
- **Wandoor Beach & Marine National Park** — A quieter beach near the Mahatma Gandhi Marine National Park — stunning views of uninhabited islands and some of the...

BEST WALKS

- **Aberdeen Bazaar to Cellular Jail** ~1.5 km | 20 min | Flat — From the heart of Port Blair's market, walk north-east along the waterfront promenade to reach the Cellular Jail entrance.
- **Aberdeen Jetty to Ross Island Boat** Short walk | 5 min | Flat — From Aberdeen Bazaar, it's a short walk to Aberdeen Jetty (Water Sports Complex) where speedboats depart every 30 minutes for Ross...

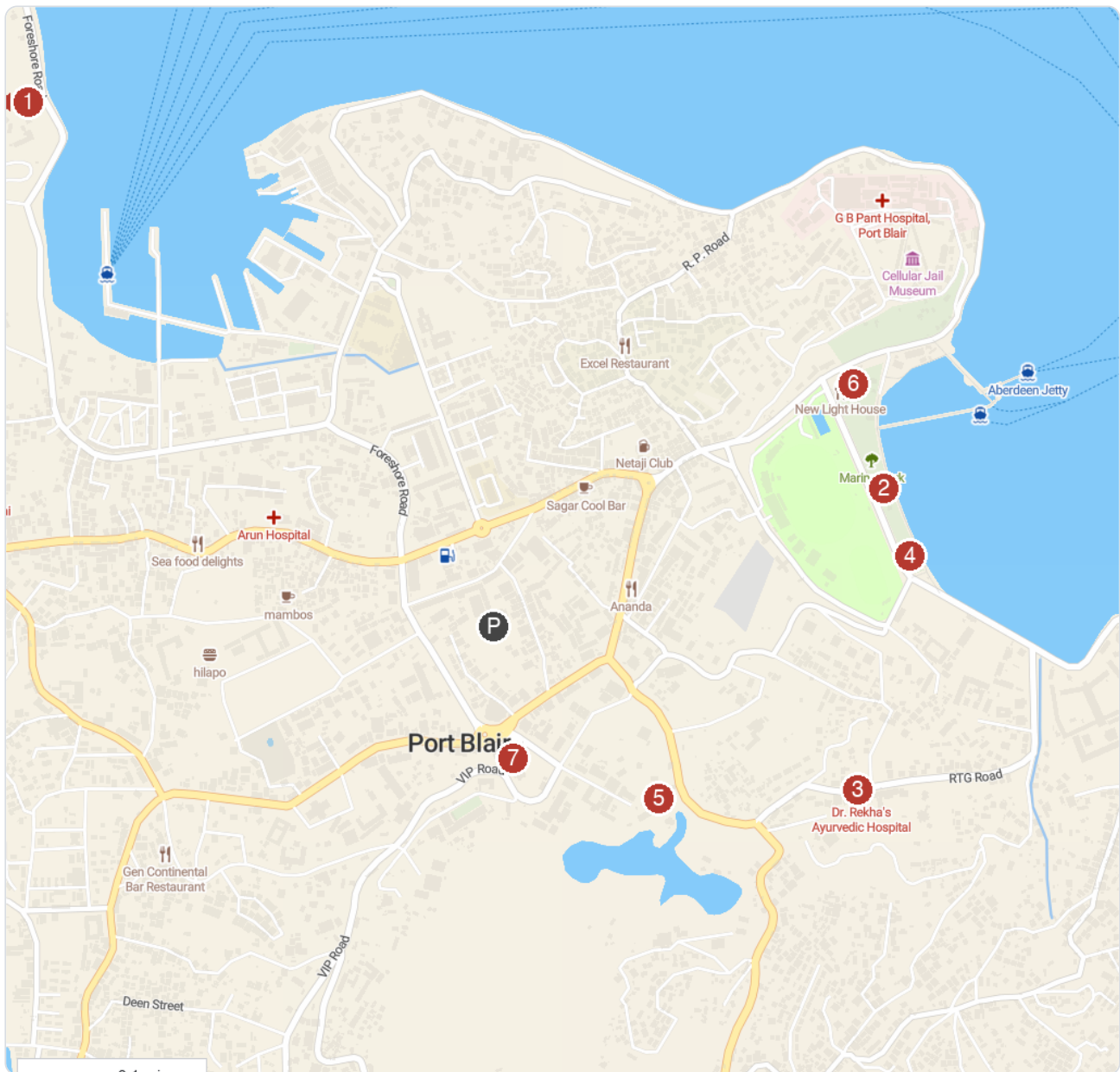
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
