GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Brennan Wharf (working commercial port; shuttle to town center)

Best For: Seafood, wildlife encounters, cage diving with great white sharks

Walk to center: ~10 min by shuttle; pedestrians not permitted through port area

Don't Miss: Coffin Bay oysters, Makybe Diva statue, sea lion swim at Hopkins Island

Getting around: **Taxi** A\$10–20 · **Hop-on hop-off** City of Port Lincoln (Rezdy)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Great White Shark Cage Diving** — The only great white shark cage diving in Australia departs from Port Lincoln.
 - **Swim with Australian Sea Lions** — Boat charter to Hopkins Island or Dangerous Reef to snorkel with wild Australian sea lions — often called the 'puppies'...
 - **Mikkira Station — Koalas in the Wild** — A historic homestead ~30 minutes from town where wild koalas live in
- low-hanging manna gum trees — you can stand inches...

 - **Coffin Bay Oyster Experience** — Drive 30 minutes to Coffin Bay to harvest and eat world-famous oysters directly from the leases.
 - **Lincoln National Park & Wild Beaches** — Rugged coastal scenery, dramatic clifftops, Fishery Bay and Sleaford Bay.

BEST WALKS

- **Tasman Terrace Foreshore Loop** 1.5 km · 30–40 min · Easy — From the Visitor Information Centre walk south along Tasman Terrace to the Makybe Diva statue on the foreshore, continue to the...
- **Winters Hill Lookout** 5 min by taxi · Steep walk not recommended · Panoramic views — Take a taxi or ride-share to the top of Winters Hill for a 360° panorama over Boston Bay, Port Lincoln, and the Eyre Peninsula.

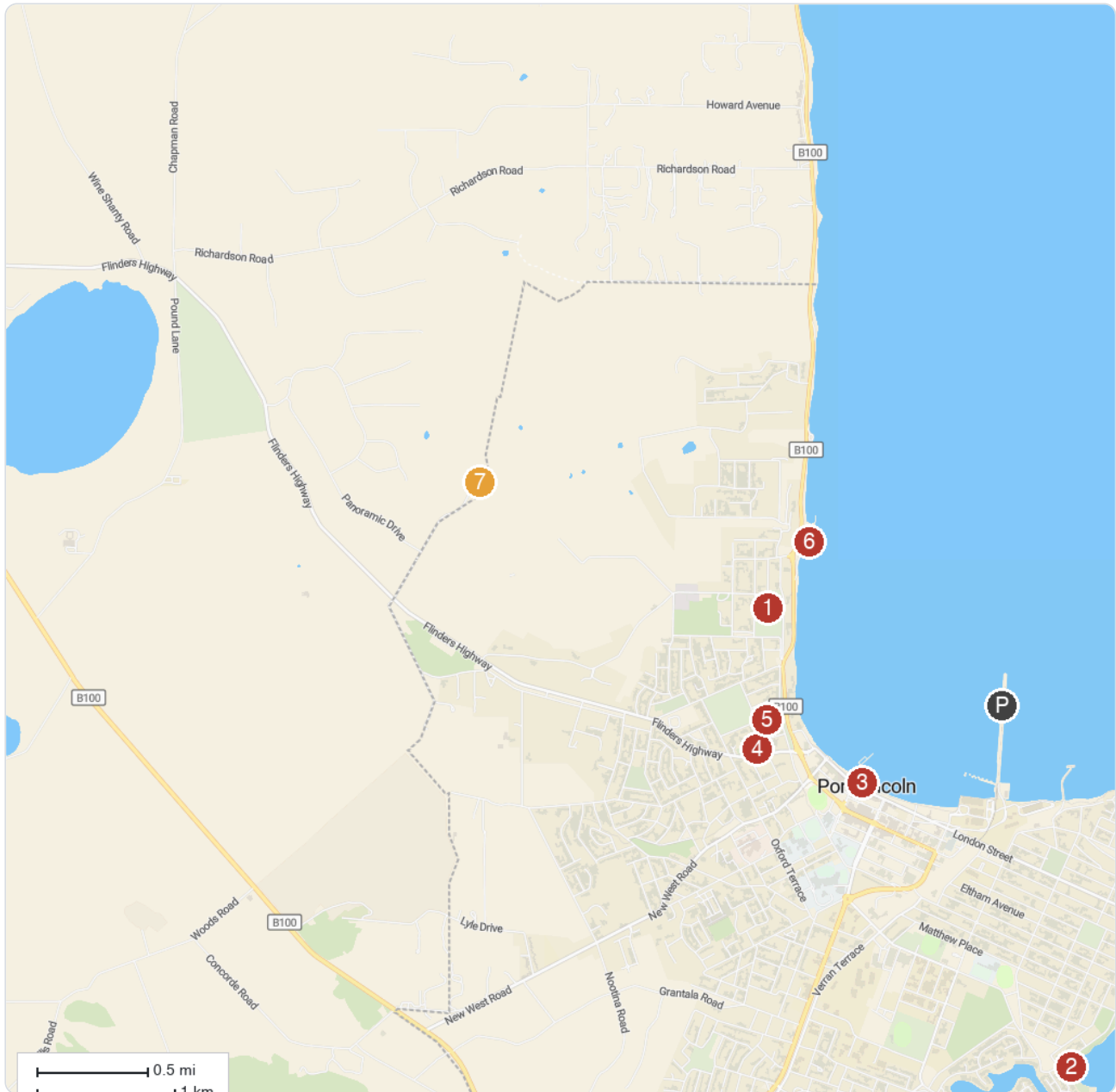
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Book wildlife tours months ahead. Shark cage diving and sea lion swims have limited spots and sell out as soon as ship schedules are published. Don't expect walk-up availability.
- Eat the seafood. Southern Bluefin Tuna, Coffin Bay oysters, King George Whiting, and Spencer Gulf prawns are world-class here.
