 - **Maracas Bay Beach Day** — 40–60 minutes over the lush Northern Range mountains and you arrive at Trinidad's most famous beach — a crescent of...
- **Fort George Panorama** — An 1804-era hilltop fort at 1,100 ft with original cannons and the best panoramic view of Port of Spain and the Gulf of...
 - **Angostura Distillery & Bitters Tour** — The world-famous Angostura Bitters are made here.
 - **Magnificent Seven & Queen's Park Savannah** — Seven spectacular Edwardian mansions line the western edge of the Savannah — Stollmeyer's Castle, Whitehall, and five...

BEST WALKS

- **King's Wharf to Woodford Square** 1.2 km · 15–20 min · Flat · Historic downtown — Walk straight from the terminal along Wrightson Road, cut north on Frederick Street through the central market area to Brian Lara...
- **Red House to National Museum** 0.6 km · 10 min · Flat · Architecture & culture — From the Red House on Woodford Square, walk north on Frederick Street to the National Museum and Art Gallery of Trinidad and Tobago...

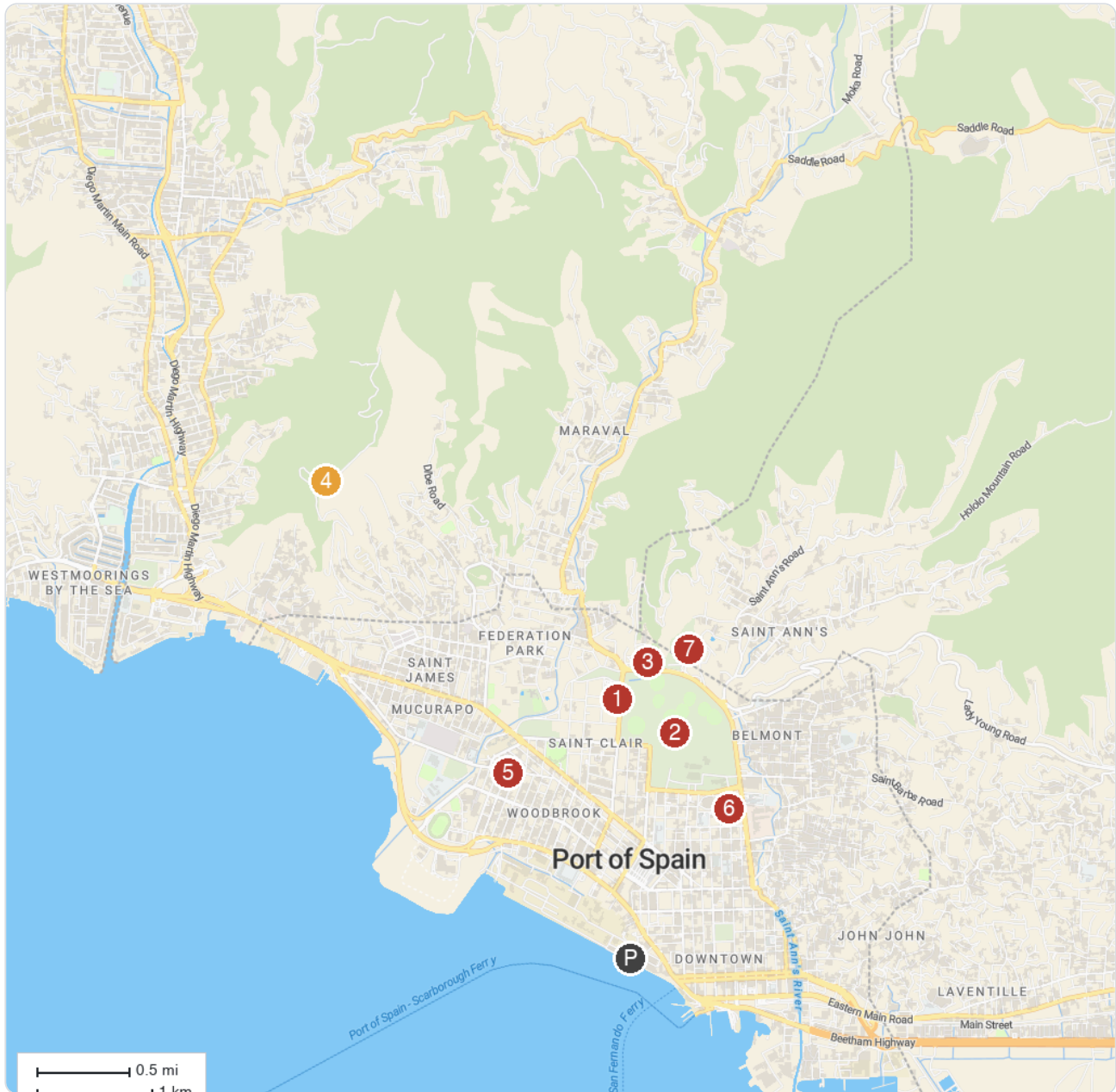
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- USD works, but carry TTD for street food. Rate is ~6.8 TTD per USD. Cards accepted at shops; street vendors and market stalls are cash only. ATMs are available in the terminal and...
- Use only H-plate taxis. Official hire taxis have plates starting with 'H'. Always agree on a fare before boarding. The terminal taxi desk posts fixed rates... use it
