- **La Maddalena Archipelago Boat Tour** — The highlight excursion from Porto Cervo.
- **Costa Smeralda Beach Day** — Hire a taxi or join a tour to Spiaggia del Principe, Liscia Ruja, or the iconic Capriccioli coves.
- **Nuragic Ruins at Nuraghe La Prisgiona** — Sardinia's mysterious Bronze Age towers are among the most impressive prehistoric monuments in Europe.
- **San Pantaleo Village & Local Market** — A charming granite hilltop village in the Gallura hinterland, just 15 minutes by taxi.
- **Kayaking & Snorkeling the Coves** — Rent a kayak from the beach or join a guided sea-kayak tour to explore the granite-fringed coves around Porto Cervo...

## BEST WALKS

- **Old Port to Stella Maris & New Marina** 1.5 km · 30–40 min · Easy — From the tender pontoon, wind up through Porto Vecchio past designer boutiques to Piazza Azzurra, then continue to Stella Maris Church...
- **Cala Granu Short Beach Walk** 1 km each way · 15 min · Easy — An easy footpath from the marina area leads to Cala Granu, the closest beach to the port — calm clear water and granite slabs good for...
