- **Valley of the Temples** — A UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the best-preserved Greek temple complexes outside Greece.
- **Scala dei Turchi** — A stunning white marl cliff sculpted by wind and sea into natural staircases, about 11 km west of Porto Empedocle near...
- **Agrigento Old Town & Montalbano Trail** — Agrigento's medieval hilltop centro storico has a striking Norman cathedral, the Via Atenea market street, and several...
- **Sicilian Food & Market Walk** — Porto Empedocle's waterfront trattorias serve fresh-caught fish, pasta con le sarde, and Sicilian cannoli at local...
- **Full-Day Combo: Temples + Scala dei Turchi** — Hire a driver or join a combo tour that hits the Valley of the Temples in the morning, then heads to Scala dei Turchi...

BEST WALKS

- **Seafront Promenade to Town Center** 1.2 km · 15 min · Easy · Flat — From the cruise pier, follow the waterfront promenade west into the heart of Porto Empedocle.
- **Vigàta Trail: Montalbano Landmarks** 2 km · 30 min · Easy · Flat — Follow the self-guided trail through town spotting locations from Camilleri's Montalbano novels and the RAI TV series.

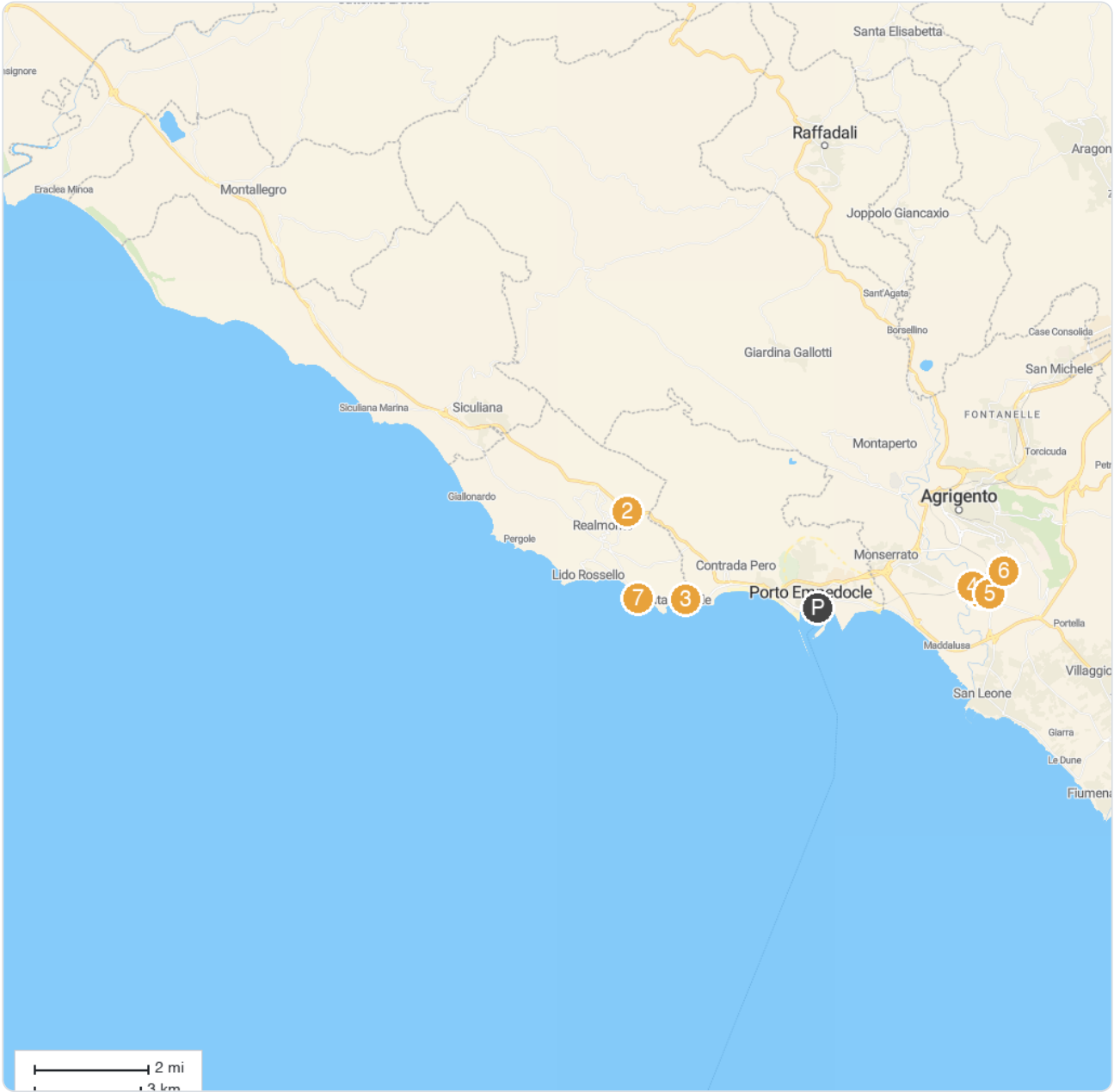
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Don't skip the Valley of the Temples. It's one of the best ancient Greek sites in the world — far better preserved than most of Greece itself. Budget at least 2 hours on site.
- Siesta is real. Shops in Porto Empedocle close 1–4:30 PM. Plan your town walk for the morning or after 5 PM.
- Carry cash. Street vendors, small cafes, and some taxis won't take cards. An ATM is available near the main piazza in town.
