- **Roman Porto Torres Walk** — Explore the ancient city of Turris Libisonis on foot: the Ponte Romano (one of Sardinia's best-preserved Roman...
- **Basilica di San Gavino** — The largest and oldest Romanesque church in Sardinia, built between 1030 and 1080, with a striking double-apse layout...
- **Asinara National Park** — Wild, car-free island national park about 20 km offshore (roughly an hour by boat), once a supermax prison and now an...
- **Sassari City Day Trip** — Sardinia's second city is 20 minutes by train.
- **Platamona Beach** — Long sandy beach with shallow turquoise water about 10 km east of Porto Torres, popular with locals.

BEST WALKS

- **Roman & Medieval Porto Torres** 2.5 km • ~45 min • Easy • History — From the cruise terminal, walk through the port gate into town, head to Ponte Romano over the Rio Mannu, continue to the...
- **Balai Beach Stroll** 1.5 km one-way • 20 min • Easy • Beach — Head northwest from the port along the coastline to Balai Beach, a small sandy cove popular for a quick dip.

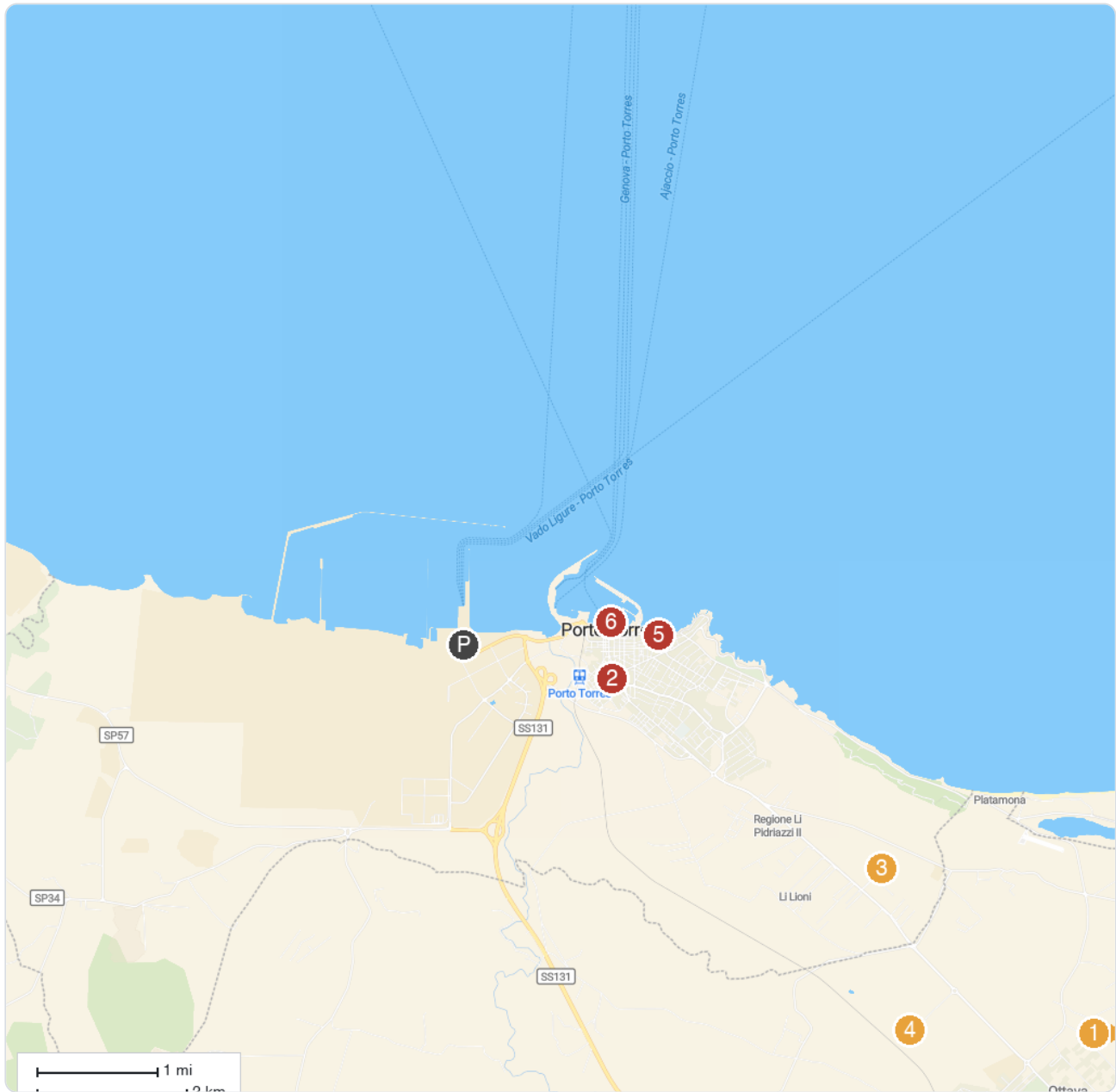
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Train to Sassari is the best value move — €2-4 each way, 20 minutes, runs several times daily. Sassari's old town is compact and rewarding.
- Book Asinara early. Island boats fill up. If Asinara is your goal, reserve before sailing — operators include Freedom and local consortium boats from Porto Torres harbor.
