TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Green Gables Heritage Place** — The red farmhouse that inspired L.M.
- **Province House — Birthplace of Canada** — This 1847 sandstone building hosted the 1864 Charlottetown Conference that led to Canadian Confederation.
- **PEI Lobster & Seafood Experience** — PEI is Canada's seafood capital — mussels, oysters, and lobster rolls are the stars.
- **Red Sand Beach & Dunes** — PEI's signature red cliffs and warm-water beaches are 25-45 min from port.
- **Confederation Centre of the Arts** — Award-winning gallery and performing arts centre in the heart of Charlottetown.

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to Downtown Heritage Loop** 2 km · 45 min · Flat & easy — Start at Peake's Quay beside the cruise terminal, stroll the harbour boardwalk past Victoria Park, then head up Great George Street...
- **Old Charlottetown Stroll** 1.5 km · 30 min · Flat — Walk Great George Street from the waterfront to St.

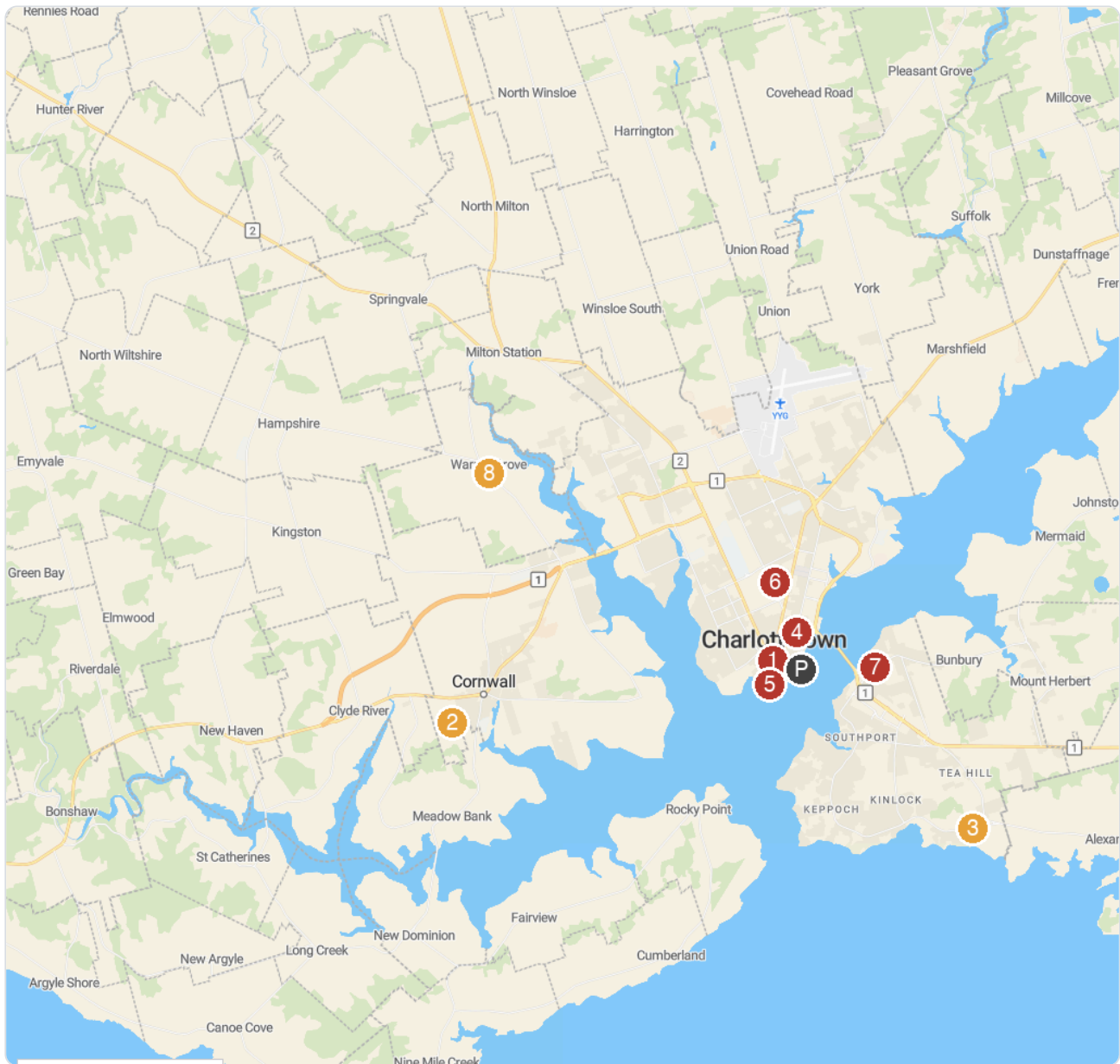
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
